## Additional Recommendations

- Tula Pink Dragons Breath 50wt Aurifil $100 \%$ cotton thread
- 80 " $\times 90$ " $(2.03 \mathrm{~m} \times 2.29 \mathrm{~m})$ batting
- 1 copy of Diamond Template (pages 11-14), or a $60^{\circ}$ diamond ruler such as the Creative Grids $60^{\circ}$

- $60^{\circ}$ triangle ruler (a long gridded rectangular ruler with a $60^{\circ}$ line will also work)

## Prep

For paper template, print pages 11-14 at 100\%/actual size, cut along dashed join lines and tape together. Then trim on outer line. Use a ruler on top when cutting diamonds to avoid trimming off the paper template.

## Cutting

Note: if using a FQ Bundle for all prints, Fabric $\mathbf{D}$ and $\mathbf{E}$ will not be fussy cut exactly as in the quilt image.
To fussy cut Fabric $\mathbf{D}$ and $\mathbf{E}$ exactly as shown, you will need $1 / 2$ yard of each.
Placement diagrams are specific to the direction of the motif; WOF (Width of Fabric- the longer side of the fat quarter) or LOF (Length of Fabric- the shorter side, also the selvage edge).
Since fabric pieces will have bias edges once cut, you may wish to starch all fabrics before cutting. Handle cut pieces gently so bias edges will not stretch.

Fabrics A-E, and L-U, cut from each:
(2) $60^{\circ}$ diamonds using the Diamond template/ruler, as shown in Fig. 1

## From Fabric I, cut:

(1) $60^{\circ}$ diamond using the Diamond template/ruler, fussy cut around the motif of your choice.

## From Fabrics $\mathrm{F}, \mathrm{G}, \mathrm{H}$, and J, cut from each:

(2) $60^{\circ}$ diamonds using the Diamond template/ruler, as shown in Fig. 2.

## From Fabric K, cut:

(9) $2^{1 / 12 "} \times$ WOF for binding
(2) $5 \frac{1}{4} 4^{" \prime} \times$ WOF; place right sides together and sub cut (6) $60^{\circ}$ Side Setting Triangles (3 each Left and Right) as shown. Fig. 3

## Fabric K cutting, continued:

(2) $15^{1 / 2 "} \times$ WOF; cut (5) $8 \frac{3}{2} / 4^{"} \times 15^{1} / 2^{"}$ rectangles, sub cut (5) Top and (5) Bottom Setting Triangles using the $60^{\circ}$ triangle ruler. Fig. 4

From remainder of strip, cut (2) $91 / 4 " \times 53 / 8$ " rectangles, place right sides together then cut once diagonally as shown to make (2) left and (2) right Corner Setting Triangles. Fig. 5

## From Fabric V, cut:

(32) $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF; cut (96) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{1} / 2$ " strips. Place (48) strips right side up and trim the ends using the $60^{\circ}$ triangle ruler (or the $60^{\circ}$ line on a gridded rectangular ruler) as shown to make (48) A sashing pieces. Place the remaining strips right side up and trim the ends at the opposite angle using the $60^{\circ}$ triangle ruler as shown to make B sashing pieces. Fig. 6

## From Fabrics W, Y, Z, AA, and EE, cut:

(1) $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF; cut the end of the strip on a $60^{\circ}$ angle and sub cut (6) diamonds using the $3^{\prime \prime}$ line of the ruler as shown. Fig. 7

## From Fabrics X, BB, CC, and DD, cut:

(1) $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF; cut the end of the strip on a $60^{\circ}$ angle and sub cut (7) diamonds using the 3 " line of the triangle ruler as shown (to use a rectangular gridded ruler, space the $60^{\circ}$ cuts $3^{\prime \prime}$ apart using the ruler grid).

## Instructions

All seam allowances are $1 / 4$ " and pieces are sewn right sides together. Press seam allowances open unless otherwise stated.

1. Sew the Fabric Y-EE diamonds together with the Fabric V A sashing pieces to make the sashing rows as shown. Press. Fig. 8
2. Referring to the Quilt Layout diagram on page 10, arrange the Fabric A-J, and L-U $60^{\circ}$ diamonds and all the Fabric K Setting Triangles together in diagonal rows, using the quilt image for fabric placement. Keep all the diamonds oriented in the same direction, and place a Fabric V B sashing piece between each diamond and between the Fabric K triangles and adjacent diamonds.
3. Sew the pieces from step 2 together into diagonal rows. Press.
4. Sew the large diamond rows together with a sashing row between each row as shown. Add the (2) remaining Fabric K Corner Setting Triangles to the upper left and bottom right corner to complete the quilt top. If desired, trim $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from the points of the small diamonds to square up, or wait until after quilting is completed to square up the quilt.
5. Sew together the $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K binding strips end-to-end using diagonal seams. Press seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
6. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top after quilting is completed.
7. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew the binding to the top of the quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12 " from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where the loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding right sides together. Trim seam to $1 / 4 / 4$ and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
8. Turn the binding to the back of quilt and hand-stitch in place.
