



Chevron Scarf

Designed for Urth Yarns

Material: 2 skeins Urth Uneek
Fingering

Size: 61" along selvedge
edge x 12" wide / 154
cm x 30.5 cm

Needle: US 3/3.25mm straight
or circular needles

Notions: Tapestry Needle

Gauge: 28 sts x 36 rows =
4"/10 cm square



Abbreviations:

Approx - Approximately

CO - Cast on

EOR - End of Round

Foll - Follow(s)

K - Knit

K2tog - Knit two stitches together

PM - Place marker

Rem - Remain/Remaining

Rep - Repeat

RS – right side

SSK - Slip slip knit

Sts – Stitches

TD - Triple decrease - slip 2 sts as if to knit, k1, pass 2 slipped sts over the k1

WS – wrong side

Pattern Notes:

The stitches will move into a chevron shape as worked and when blocked.

Pattern:

CO 130

Row 1: Sl1, k1, *k1, yo, k29, td, k29, yo, k1, rep from * once, k2,

Row 2: Sl 1, purl all sts

Repeat rows 1 -2 until work measures 61"/154 cm from cast on edge

Bind Off
