

Ruler Work Garden Quilt Design Ruler Class

Supplies List:

- Garden Quilt Design template set (includes 4 templates and one crosshair ruler)
- Extension Table
- Ruler Foot
- Spacing Gauge
- Machingers quilting gloves
- Grid Glider (peach color for smaller extension tables / green for larger extension tables)
- Tweezers
- Chaco pen or Frixion pen in a color that will show against your fabric
- Thread that will show up against your fabric color (suggest Floriani 40 wt or Glide 40 wt)
- 14 Top Stitch needle (Janome machines should use a Janome Purple top needle)
- Three quilt sandwiches ***(it is important to cut these to the exact size specified below)***
(Suggest medium to dark colors in order to better see the reference lines on your templates):
 - One 14" quilt sandwich for practice *(A quilt sandwich consists of a top, batting, and backing)*
 - One 16" quilt sandwich for making a small sampler of the design
 - One Table Topper / Wall Hanging sandwich *(See cutting sewing instructions below.)*
Your choice of:
 - One 29" Table Topper / Wall Hanging (24" center w/1" Inner Border and 1.5" Outer Border)
OR
 - One 33" Table Topper / Wall Hanging (24" center w/1" Inner Border and 4" Outer Border)
- **To make the Table Topper / Wall Hanging:**
 - Cut 16 assorted squares 6.5" x 6.5"
 - Sew together in 4 rows of 4 squares with scant 1/4" seams
Quilt should now measure 24.5" x 24.5"
 - Cut 4 Inner Border strips 1.5" x WOF (width of fabric)
 - Attach side Inner Borders first, pressing seams toward outer edge. Then attach top/bottom Inner Borders, pressing seams toward outer edge.
Quilt should now measure 27.5" x 27.5"
 - Cut 4 Outer Border strips 2" x WOF (or 4" x WOF if you prefer a wider Outer Border)
 - Attach side Outer Borders first, pressing seams toward Inner Border. Then attach top/bottom Outer Borders, pressing seams toward Inner Border
 - Cut Batting and Backing at 32" x 32" (for quilt with smaller Outer Border) or 36" x 36" (for quilt with larger Outer Border)
 - For Binding, cut 3 strips 2.5" (or 2.25" – your preference) x WOF. Join together and attach **after** quilting is complete
