You will learn how to:

- Choose fabrics for the purpose of the pillow
- Piece and/or quilt the surface for interest
- Simple envelope closure
- Zipper & button closures
- Backing, piecing, quilting, pleating
- Add trims and embellishments
- Reinforce the fabric for structure
- Use buttons and zippers for closurese




Supplies

You will want to bring:

- Scissors, 8 inch and 5 inch, very sharp
- Rotary cutter with sharp blade
- Silk pins with glass heads
- Your sewing machine
- Selection of machine needles from fine to heavy
- Zipper foot (or feet)
- Fabric, prewashed, if desired, Elfriede & staff can help you choose appropriate fabrics for what you want to accomplish
- Marking pencils or chalk
- Your lunch

You will take home:

- Instructions for various pillow cover styles, sewing techniques and order of assembly
- Instructions for zipper applications, lapped and invisible, and when to use each
- Information on when & how to use button holes, button loops, frogs & ties as closures

- Instructions on how to add pop-out cordings and fringes
- A simple completed pillow cover and tehcniques to design your next project
