Bunnies Go Round Block Pattern

Makes one 12-1/2" square.

Bunny Fabric:

A. one 8-1/2" square

B. two 8-1/2" x 4-1/2"

rectangles

Background Fabric:


C. three 4-1/2" squares

D. one 2-1/2" square


Sewing Instructions:

1.Sew unit D to corner of unit A along diagonal line using flipping corner method. Press toward corner. Trim away scrap under corner. Finishes 8-1/2" square with 2-1/2" half square triangle (HST) in one corner.

2. Mark for HST on two of unit C.
Sew one to the upper left of one B unit.
Sew the other to the upper right of remaining B unit.
Fold back corner and press. Trim away excess.
Finishes 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" with the 4-1/2" HST on one end.
The two HST should be opposing the rectangles.




3. Sew the last C unit to the top of one B unit. Sew the second B unit to the top of A unit. Refer to photo for accurate placement.



4. Sew the B/C unit to the side of A/B unit. Finished block 12-1/2".



^{*}The whiskers are made with a small zig zag stitch and buttons are used for the eyes on the sample.







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
