

Arctic Star Class Supply List

Pre-cutting the fabrics is a mandatory requirement prior to taking this class. The only pre-cutting you need to do is to cut the strips that are listed in the fabric guide and have them labeled and in their corresponding bags. I will take you through how to read your pattern and further cut your material.

Fabric Selection: Please refer to the yardage on the back of your pattern for the required fabric amounts. Also look on the back side of this sheet for a fabric guide with cutting instructions.

Preparing your Foundation Papers: Please read and follow the instructions for "Foundation Papers and Templates" on page 2.

Note: PLEASE PAY SPECIAL ATTENTION THAT YOU DO NOT CONFUSE FOUNDATION PAPERS WITH TEMPLATE LAYOUT SHEETS.



- **Foundation Papers:** These are the foundations that you will sew the fabric directly onto. These need to be trimmed leaving a 1/8' border. Do not cut the individual units apart.
- **Template Layout Sheets:** The template layout sheets are used to cut your fabric. You will cut through these templates when you cut certain parts of your fabric. These need to be trimmed leaving a 1/16" border and used per the directions in the pattern.
- **Templates:** The templates are also used to cut your fabric. Unlike template layout sheets where you don't have to be exact when cutting out your fabric using them, with templates you must be exact when cutting out your fabric.
- **Note:** Once these pieces are cut out place them into their respective bags. You will find that information on page three in booklet one and on pages one and two of booklet two.

The following items will be used in class:

- Sewing Machine with a Quarter-inch foot
- Medium Size Cutting Mat (a nice size is 18"x 24")
- Rotary Cutter
- Size 70 Needles
- Scissors
- Seam Ripper
- 12" Add-a-Quarter Ruler
- Glue Stick (we like to use the Scotch Repositionable Glue Stick or Scotch Restickable Glue Stick)
- Purple Thang (Optional)
- Glue Pen (Fons & Porter, Sewline or Avery)
- Ruler (please bring a ruler for trimming up units, whatever your favorite sized ruler is will be fine)
- High Quality Cotton Sewing Thread
- Pattern
- Pins – (Judy recommends flower pins, but any pin that you prefer would be fine).
- Paper Clips (My favorite are the jumbo-sized paper clips that you can buy in a box of 100)
- Ziploc Bags (1 gallon size or 2 gallon size)

<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric AN1:a $\left(\frac{1}{4} \text{ yard}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (1) $7\frac{1}{2}$" x 42" strip and label it Fabric AN1:a.
<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric AN1:b $\left(\frac{1}{4} \text{ yard}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (1) $7\frac{1}{2}$" x 42" strip and label it Fabric AN1:b.
<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric AN2 $\left(\frac{3}{4} \text{ yard}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (3) $7\frac{3}{4}$" x 42" strips; clip these together and label them Fabric AN2.
<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric AN3 $\left(\frac{1}{2} \text{ yard}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (4) $3\frac{3}{4}$" x 42" strips; clip these together and label them Fabric AN3.
<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric AN4 $\left(\frac{3}{4} \text{ yard}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (3) 9" x 42" strips; clip these together and label them Fabric AN4.
<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric AN5:a $\left(\frac{1}{8} \text{ yard}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (1) $2\frac{3}{4}$" x 42" strip and label it Fabric AN5:a.
<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric AN5:b $\left(\frac{1}{8} \text{ yard}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (1) $2\frac{3}{4}$" x 42" strip and label it Fabric AN5:b.
<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric AN5:c $\left(\frac{1}{8} \text{ yard}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (1) $2\frac{3}{4}$" x 42" strip and label it Fabric AN5:c.
<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric AN5:d $\left(\frac{1}{8} \text{ yard}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (1) $2\frac{3}{4}$" x 42" strip and label it Fabric AN5:d.
<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric AN5:e $\left(\frac{1}{8} \text{ yard}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (1) $2\frac{3}{4}$" x 42" strip and label it Fabric AN5:e.

<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric B1 $\left(1\frac{7}{8} \text{ yards}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (12) $5\frac{1}{2}" \times 42"$ strips; clip these strips together and label them Fabric B1.
<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric B2:a $\left(\frac{3}{8} \text{ yard}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (1) $11\frac{1}{4}" \times 42"$ strip and label it Fabric B2:a.
<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric B2:b $\left(\frac{3}{8} \text{ yard}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (1) $11\frac{1}{4}" \times 42"$ strip and label it Fabric B2:b.
<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric B2:c $\left(\frac{3}{8} \text{ yard}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (1) $11\frac{1}{4}" \times 42"$ strip and label it Fabric B2:c.
<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric B2:d $\left(\frac{3}{8} \text{ yard}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (1) $11\frac{1}{4}" \times 42"$ strip and label it Fabric B2:d.
<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric B3 $\left(\frac{1}{2} \text{ yard}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (1) $16" \times 42"$ strip and label it Fabric B3.
<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric B4:a $\left(\frac{1}{4} \text{ yard}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (1) $5\frac{1}{2}" \times 42"$ strip and label it Fabric B4:a.
<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric B4:b $\left(\frac{1}{4} \text{ yard}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (1) $5\frac{1}{2}" \times 42"$ strip and label it Fabric B4:b.

Fabric Guide for Glacier New York Beauty

<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric JD1 $\left(\frac{3}{8} \text{ yard}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (2) $5\frac{1}{2}" \times 42"$ strips; clip these strips together and label them Fabric JD1.
<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric JD2:a $\left(\frac{1}{8} \text{ yard}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 42"$ strips; clip these strips together and label them Fabric JD2:a.
<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric JD2:b $\left(\frac{1}{8} \text{ yard}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (2) $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 42"$ strips; clip these strips together and label them Fabric JD2:b.

<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric JD3 $\left(\frac{1}{8} \text{ yard}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (1) $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 42"$ strip and label it Fabric JD3.
<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric JD4 $\left(1\frac{1}{8} \text{ yards}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (4) $9\frac{1}{2}" \times 42"$ strips; clip these strips together and label them Fabric JD4.
<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric JD5:a $\left(\frac{3}{8} \text{ yards}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (4) $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 42"$ strips; clip these strips together and label them Fabric JD5:a.
<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric JD5:b $\left(\frac{3}{8} \text{ yards}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (4) $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 42"$ strips; clip these strips together and label them Fabric JD5:b.

There is a diagram on page 17 and page 35 of your pattern that shows where each of these fabrics is located within the quilt. Please place these strips in a bag labeled Unit JD Bag. We will further cut these strips down in class.

Fabric Guide for Winter Migrations Border

<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric C1 $\left(\frac{7}{8} \text{ yard}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (4) $7\frac{3}{4}" \times 42"$ strips; clip these strips together and label them Fabric C1.
<i>NGlue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric C2 $\left(1\frac{1}{8} \text{ yards}\right)$	<p>Please Note: Fabric C2 is used as the geese in the outside border. These can be cut from a single fabric or can be cut from multiple fabrics. In my quilt sample I chose to use eight different fabrics cutting two strips from each fabric. In either case you will need to cut:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (16) $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 42"$ strips; clip these strips together and label them Fabric C2.
<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric C3 $\left(1\frac{7}{8} \text{ yards}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (16) $4" \times 42"$ strips; clip these strips together and label them Fabric C3.
<i>Glue fabric swatch here</i>	Fabric C4 $\left(1\frac{1}{8} \text{ yards}\right)$	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cut (4) $9\frac{1}{2}" \times 42"$ strips; clip these strips together and label them Fabric C4.

There is a diagram on page 24 and page 35 of your pattern that shows where each of these fabrics is located within the quilt. Please place these strips in a bag labeled Unit C Bag. We will further cut these strips down in class.
