Feathered Dreams Table Runner Instructor: Shirley Horton

This is a beautiful table runner or bed runner made using the Westalee Design's Elegant Feathered Leaf Quilting Templates. This project uses a special technique called Templee Quilting. I am sure you will enjoy making this lovely project.

This lovely table runner or bed runner uses the Elegant Feather Leaf Circle Template and Original Feather Leaf Templates. You can enjoy doing the pattern I have created, or create your own pattern. This project is a lot of fun. Bring your creative juices with you.

Skill Level: Must have previous experience with quilting rulers. Finished size: 18" x 53" or whatever size you decide to create

Pattern(Book)—Janet Collins Designs feathered dreams Materials/Supplies Needed to make the table runner*:

3 yds of fabric for back ground and backing.

1 ½ yd fabric for contrasting color

Thread color of your choice. Your thread color could match your contrasting color of

fabric. Bobbin should match you backing.

Sharp snips (I like OESD's serrated edged snips) 90/14 Topstich needle.

Regular sewing and quilting supplies

Westalee Feathered Leaf Templates

Westalee Feathered Leaf Circle Templates.

Flat extension table for quilting.

Ruler Foot

Glider

12.5 or 8" crosshair ruler 8 point

Marking tools

4 Practice squares of fabric batting and backing. 20"

Very thin Crib size Batting (I like to use quilters dream request.)

3 yds of web backing such as heat and bond lite.

*if you would like to make the quilt as pictured on the book, see the fabric requirements inside the book to purchase the correct amounts!

This is an all-day class. Feel free to bring something to eat and drink while you work on your project. We will be providing some snacks throughout the retreat. We have both a microwave and fridge in the class space that you can utilize throughout the retreat if you would like to bring lunch.

You will learn: How to use the Westalee Feathered Leaf Templates, Marking and Designing, Templee quilting and quilt as you go method.

HOMEWORK PRIOR TO CLASS

Do this if you are going to follow my exact pattern.

Cut 2 - 21" squares of background. this will be for the top and the backing. Also, cut a piece of batting 21"

Cut 4 – 12"X18" of background fabric and 2 pieces of batting

Cut 4 - 18"x15" of background fabric and 2 pieces of batting
