

## Final Steps

- ◆ Next, take your rows 1-6 and sew rows together in that order to complete your quilt top.
- ◆ Quilt as desired.
- ◆ Finished size - 51" x 63"

## Fabric Requirements

- ◆ Quilt Top 1 Layer Cake - or 42 x 10" Squares
- ◆ Backing 55" x 70" Fabric of choice
- ◆ Batting 55" x 70" of choice
- ◆ Binding 1/2 yard Fabric of choice.

## Fabric Suggestions

- ◆ Works best with light, medium and dark contrasting colors.  
Use smaller prints if you want to accent the quilting design.



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# Layer Cake Love

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## Pattern Instructions:

- ◆ Sort your 10" squares into **6 stacks of 7 pieces** of fabric in each pile.
- ◆ Sew each stack of **7 pieces** of fabric together to make **6 rows**, each row will measure approximately 67" long by 10" wide.
- ◆ Press all seams open.
- ◆ Take each row one at a time and fold them **end to end twice** being careful to line up their the edges. Take a look at this video online to make certain get this step correctly - <https://youtu.be/eVz9sak2sEq>
- ◆ Take your folded strip and lay it in front of you so it is **vertical**. Each row will be folded in this manner.



- ◆ You will be cutting each row and stacking them in the following order:

**Row 1: cut in 4" from the left.**

place the 4" piece to your **right**

and the 6" piece to your **left**

**Row 2: cut in 1.5" from the left.**

add the 1.5" piece to the pile to your left

and add the 8.5" piece to the pile on your right

**Row 3: cut in 3.5" from the left.**

add the 3.5" piece to the pile to your right

and add the 6.5" piece to the pile on your left

**Row 4: cut in 2" from the left.**

add the 2" piece to the pile to your left

and add the 8" piece to the pile on your right

**Row 5: cut in 4" from the left.**

add the 4" piece to the pile to your right

and add the 6" piece to the pile on your left

**Row 6: cut in 1.5" from the left.**

add the 1.5" piece to the pile to your left

and the 8.5" piece to the pile on your right

- ◆ Next step is to take your pile on the **right** and flip it over so the last piece you cut is now on the bottom (8.5" strip) and the first piece (4" strip) is on the top,
- ◆ Take the top strip from the pile on the **left** (1.5") and sew it to the **top strip** from the pile on the right (4"), sew right sides together the length of the two strips. Once sewn begin a new pile. Continue to do this for the remainder of strips stacking them on top of the other. Add to your pile, when all the strips are sewn you will have 6 rows.
