About the Class

Do you need to make a quick baby quilt or wedding gift for someone and not sure where to start? Come learn how to choose 3 coordinating and or contrasting fabrics (or bring your own stash to go through) to make a beginner friendly 3-yard quilt. In class, we will be choosing the pattern, fabrics, and begin cutting and even sewing (if time allows). Bobbie will help guide you in color and pattern choices. Each month we will focus on a new quilt selection. These are lap to large lap size quilts and can be made bigger with more fabric (see Fabric Café books and patterns for more details).

What you will learn:

1. How to use up orphan 1-yard cuts you have stashed away in your closet
2. Understanding how to use some basic color and fabric print choices when putting together a quilt
3. How to have fun with other quilters like you!

- Bring your own machine and basic sewing supplies
