The Hunter's Star Trim Tool makes creating these fun blocks easy and stress free. Accurately assemble them from simple squares and rectangles

Pattern: Aquila by Deb Heatherly

Fabric Requirements:

Background - 1/2 yard

Red Fabric - 1/3 yard

Blue Fabric - 5/8 yard

Binding - 1/3 yard

Cutting Requirements:

Please have everything cut out before class, we will be doing the subcutting in class. I would recommend treating all fabrics with Best Press or a similar starching agent. We will be sewing on the bias; this will alleviate stretching and distortion.

Background -

(12) - 2" x 4.75" rectangles

(24) - 2" x 5" rectangles

(6) - 5.5" x 5.5" squares

Red Fabric -

(24) - 2" x 5" rectangles

(3) - 1.5" x WOF strips for Inner Border

Blue Fabric -

(12) - 2" x 4.75" rectangles

(6) - 5.5" x 5.5" squares

(3) - 3" x WOF strips for Outer Border

Binding -

(4) - 2.5" x WOF strips

Basic Sewing Supplies

Sewing Machine in good working condition - table attachment if applicable

Thread

Machine Needles

Fabric Scissors or Snips

Seam Ripper

Straight Pins

Rotary Cutter

Small Cutting Mat – Rotating or Stationary

Pen or Pencil & Paper for notes

Best Press

Personal Iron & Mat – Optional

Diagonal Seam Tape – Optional
