

Grids Girls 1: Cats on the Table Supply List

Cat's Cradle Ruler

Learn how to use the Cat's Cradle Ruler to make easy cat's cradle units with NO Y seams!! This ruler can make units from as small as 1.5" to as big as 4".

Pattern: Cats on the Table by Deb Heatherly

Fabric Requirements:

Cat's Cradle Units

(6) 5" – Assorted Prints OR (23) 2.5" - Assorted Prints

1/4 yard - Background

3/8 yard - Coordinating "Solid" (Sashing & Large Triangles)

Outer Border - 1/4 yard

Binding - 1/4 yard

This is a great project to use leftovers from a charm pack or a random mini charm you've been hanging on to! It is best for the background and the coordinating "solid" to both contrast and compliment with the assorted prints. What that means is that you want to use fabrics that coordinate with the assorted prints but don't blend in with them. Think about what colors could make your prints pop! You are not obligated to use a solid fabric. You can use a grunge, tone on tone, small print, or anything that fits your vision.

Cutting Requirements:

Please have everything cut out before class. I would recommend treating all Cat's Cradle unit fabrics with Best Press or a similar starching agent. We will be sewing on the bias; this will alleviate stretching and distortion.

Assorted Prints:

(23) - 2.5" squares

Background Fabric:

(12) - 2.5" x 4" rectangles

(12) - 2.5" x 3.5" rectangles

Coordinating "Solid":

(6) - 4.5" x 5.5" rectangles

(10) - 2.5" x 9.5" rectangles

Outer Border: (3) – 2 ½" x WOF strips

Basic Sewing Supplies

Sewing Machine in good working condition - table attachment if applicable

Thread

Machine Needles

Fabric Scissors or Snips

Seam Ripper

Straight Pins

Rotary Cutter

Small Cutting Mat – Rotating or Stationary

Fabric Marking Pen

Pen or Pencil & Paper for notes

Best Press

Personal Iron & Mat – Optional

Diagonal Seam Tape – Optional
