

## Crazy Quilt Papers Supply List

No pattern is needed for this class, just a packet of Crazy Quilt 10" Papers designed by Lori Holt. A quilt made with 42 10" squares will make a quilt 48" x 56" as each block will finish at 8". Feel free to make it larger or smaller. Variety is important; that's why a Layer Cake is helpful. Blocks can also be sewn into a pillow or table runner.

### Supplies and Materials:

10" Crazy Quilt Papers. You can get these at Prairie Point

1 Layer Cake or 42 10" squares

8½" square ruler for trimming up blocks, or larger.

### *Also:*

- Rotary mat – a small 12" x 18" is convenient, but any this size or larger will do.
- Rotary cutter with sharp blade.
- Having your own small iron at your sewing station is helpful but not required.
- Sewing machine in good working order.
- Quarter-inch presser foot or your method for achieving the ¼" seam allowance.
- Don't forget the cord and foot pedal.
- Sharp needle size 12: Microtex or Topstitch.
- The usual sewing supplies: thread, bobbins, pins, scissors, seam ripper, etc.

If you want to use the 5" papers and Charm squares that is an option for you.

This is a great beginner project because your piecing need not be precise until you sew the completed blocks together; and because it's a great way to practice handling your rotary cutter. The 5-hour class gives you more time to get a lot accomplished and to have confidence in completing the quilt.
