Fiesta Bag Supply List

- 1. 6 coordinating fat quarters
 - Top of bag (above striped pockets)
 - Bottom of bag (below bag pockets)
 - Striped pockets (3 different fat quarters
 - Bindings
- 2. 1 ¼ yard bag lining for handles, pocket trim and placket
- 3. Thread
- 4. 1 ½ yards of 34" batting, Soft and Stable or double-sided fusible Bosal
- 5. ¼ yard fusible pellon fleece
- 6. ¼ yard Shape-Flex
- 7. 124" zipper
- 8. Pattern
- 9. Foam Core for bottom of bag optional

Basic Sewing Supplies:

Sewing machine in good working condition – table attachment if applicable Thread Machine needles – Microtex 80 or 90 Fabric scissors or snips Seam ripper Straight pins Rotary cutter Cutting mat Fabric marking pen Pen or pencil

Cutting Instructions:

Follow cutting instructions with some exceptions:

- Cut 22" pieces wherever they say 20"
- For handles, cut (2) 4 ¹/₂" wide strips of fusible Pellon fleece
- Cut (2) 7" by 22" strips of fusible Pellon fleece for pockets
- Cut (2) 4" x 22" pieces of fabric (your choice) for zipper plackets I usually use lining fabric
- Cut (2) 4" strips of Shape-Flex for zipper strips
- Cut (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips for binding side seams
- Cut (1) 10" x 18" piece for covering Foam Core (optional)
