

Free Motion Quilting

-Class Supply List

****** So this class runs smoothly and on time, it is important to be prepared, setup and ready when class begins with the following:

- Sewing machine with drop feed-dog function and extension table.
- Walking foot (helpful if you have one).
- Free Motion Quilting Foot (and screw driver for your machine)
- Light solid cotton or muslin quilt sandwich (top, batting, back, all cut to approx 36"x 30", spray baste or pinned together. Must have this ready before class start time). It will be helpful if the fabrics you select are different for the top & back, either by color, tone on tone, or a grunge type fabric -just remember to select white or light hues.
- Dark or Bright contrasting 50 wt Thread (can be cotton or poly).
- 2 or 3 Bobbins loaded with same Thread
- Fresh Needle- (90/14 or 80/12 -both usually work fine).
- Water soluble or Erasable pen -for marking (Fine Point blue Mark-B-Gone by Dritz or a Frixion pen).
- 24"x 6" or larger Quilt Ruler
- Scissors/Snips, Seam Ripper & Tweezers
- Several sheets of plain white 8x11 computer paper and ink pen, pencil or marker.

***** *Very helpful and recommended but not required:***

- 1) Supreme Slider silicone mat (I use the queen size)
- 2) Quilting Gloves (I use Machingers)
- 3) An "orphan quilt block" - sandwiched and prepared to practice on if the spirit moves you. :)
