Sewing machine in good working order. (Don't forget **power cord and foot pedal**)

Bobbins

Free motion foot or darning foot. Free motion is easier to work with. If you do not have one check with a sewing machine dealer.

Machiners gloves

Topstitching **needles** Superior or Schmetz – size 14

Brush for cleaning your machine

Paper and pen for taking notes

Sewing machine manual/user guide

Aurifil or Mettler thread

Kit for quilting – pick up and purchase on class day. \$6.

I will show other items you might want to purchase such as Supreme Slider, spray baste, basting pins, other threads, stencils, and more.

Please be familiar with your sewing machine. If you have not used it for quite a while spend some time sewing on it.

In this class I hope to teach you the very basics necessary to begin free-motion quilting. Once you build up your confidence you may want to learn more advanced techniques with some of the wonderful books available or with a more advanced class.
