

Grids Girls 1: Jubilant Supply List

Half Rectangle Trim Tool

The Half Rectangle Trim Tool designed by Deb Heatherly makes half rectangle units in seven different sizes ranging from 1in x 2in to 4in x 8in.

Pattern: Jubilant by Homemade Emily Jane

Fabric Requirements: Throw Size 66" x 66"

Prints - 13 - 1/8 yard or 32 - 10" squares or various scraps

Background - 3 1/4 yards

Binding - 1/2 yard

Cutting Requirements:

Please have everything cut out before class, we will be doing the subcutting in class. I would recommend treating all fabrics with Best Press or a similar starching agent. We will be sewing on the bias; this will alleviate stretching and distortion.

Background:

Cut (5) - 8" x WOF strips

Subcut into (64) - 4" x 8" rectangles

Cut (2) - 6.5" x WOF Strips

Subcut into (32) - 6.5" x 2.5"

Cut (2) - 14.5" x WOF Strips

Subcut into (28) - 14.5" x 2.5" rectangles

Cut (12) - 2.5" x WOF Strips

Save for horizontal and vertical sashing.

Prints:

From Each Print (1/8 yard)

Cut (5) - 4" x 8" rectangles

From Each Print (10" squares)

Cut (2) - 4" x 8" rectangles

If using scraps total prints needed - (64) - 4" x 8" rectangles

Binding -

(7) - 2.5" x WOF strips

Basic Sewing Supplies

Sewing Machine in good working condition - table attachment if applicable

Thread

Machine Needles

Fabric Scissors or Snips

Seam Ripper

Straight Pins

Rotary Cutter

Small Cutting Mat – Rotating or Stationary

Pen or Pencil & Paper for notes

Best Press

Personal Iron & Mat – Optional

Diagonal Seam Tape – Optional
