

Grids Girls 1: Moody Blues Supply List

Ultimate Flying Geese Ruler

Learn how to use the Ultimate Flying Geese Ruler to make 4 at a time flying geese with minimal waste. This ruler can make sizes from ½" x 1" units to 4" x 8" units. Very versatile!!

Pattern: Moody Blues by Deb Heatherly

Fabric Requirements:

Assorted Prints – (6) – 10" square or 1/6 yard or 6" square scrap

Background – 1/2 yard

Outer Border – 1/4 yard

Binding – 1/4 yard

Cutting Requirements:

Please have everything cut out before class. I would recommend treating all flying geese unit fabrics with Best Press or a similar starching agent. We will be sewing on the bias; this will alleviate stretching and distortion.

From each Print:

(1) – 5 3/4" Square

(1) – 1 1/2" Square

Background:

(24) – 3 1/4" Squares

(2) – 2" x 9 1/2" Rectangles

(12) – 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" Rectangles

(3) – 1 1/2" x WOF Strips

Outer Border:

(3) – 2 1/2" x WOF Strips

Binding:

(2) – 2 1/2" x WOF Strips

Basic Sewing Supplies

Sewing Machine in good working condition - table attachment if applicable

Thread

Machine Needles

Fabric Scissors or Snips

Seam Ripper

Straight Pins

Rotary Cutter

Small Cutting Mat – Rotating or Stationary

Fabric Marking Pen

Pen or Pencil & Paper for notes

Best Press

Personal Iron & Mat – Optional

Diagonal Seam Tape – Optional
