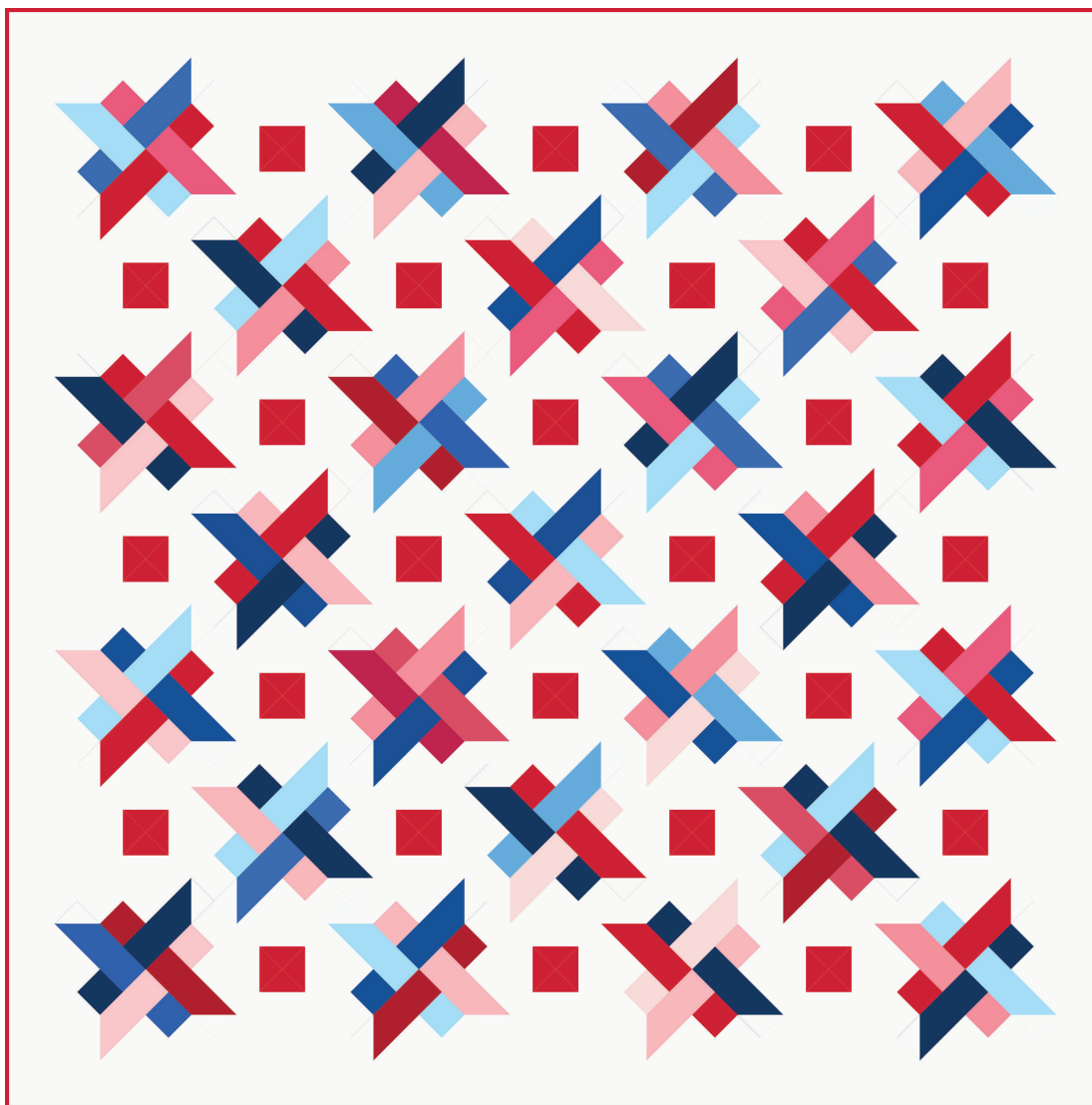




CELTIC KNOTS

Pattern by Susan Guzman for *moda*

Quilt Size: $68\frac{1}{2}" \times 68\frac{1}{2}"$



FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Prints: 1 Jelly Roll* or 25 strips – $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 42"$

Block Corners: $\frac{1}{2}$ yard

Background: $3\frac{5}{8}$ yards

Binding: $\frac{5}{8}$ yard

Backing: $4\frac{3}{8}$ yards

*Jelly Roll = 40 – $2\frac{1}{2}" \times$ width of fabric (WOF) strips

CELTIC KNOTS

Quilt Size: 68½" x 68½"

Cutting Requirements:

WOF = width of fabric.

From Jelly Roll:

- From each of (25) strips, cut:
 - (4) 2½" x 6½" rectangles (100 total).
 - (4) 2½" x 2½" squares (100 total).

From block corners fabric, cut:

- (6) 2½" x WOF strips. From strips, subcut:
 - (96) 2½" x 2½" squares.

From background fabric, cut:

- (2) 18¼" x WOF strips. From strips, subcut:
 - (3) 18¼" x 18¼" squares. Cut each square twice diagonally for 4 side setting triangles (12 total).

From background fabric, cont:

- (2) 9⅜" x 9⅜" squares. Cut each square once diagonally for 2 corner triangles (4 total).
- (4) 4½" x 4½" squares.
- (12) 4½" x WOF strips. From strips, subcut:
 - (96) 4½" x 4½" squares (+ 4 from above =100 total).
- (13) 2½" x WOF strips. From strips, subcut:
 - (200) 2½" x 2½" squares.

From binding fabric, cut:

- (8) 2½" x WOF strips.

Piecing, Assembly, and Finishing:

Arrows indicate pressing direction.

MAKE BLOCKS

1. Sew (1) 2½" Jelly Roll square to (1) 2½" background square to make a 2½" x 4½" 2-square rectangle, as shown. Make 100.
2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (96) 2½" block corner squares (*set aside*) and (100) 2½" background squares. Place a marked background square onto one end of a Jelly Roll 2½" x 6½" rectangle. Stitch together on the drawn line, trim a ¼" seam allowance, and press to make a pieced rectangle. Make 100.
3. Lay out (4) 4½" background squares, (4) assorted 2-square rectangles, and (4) matching 2½" x 6½" pieced rectangles, as shown. Sew the 4½" square to the top edge of the 2-squares rectangle, then

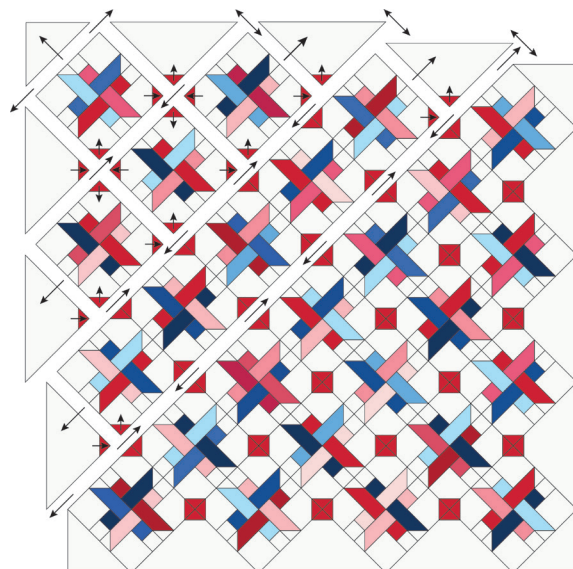
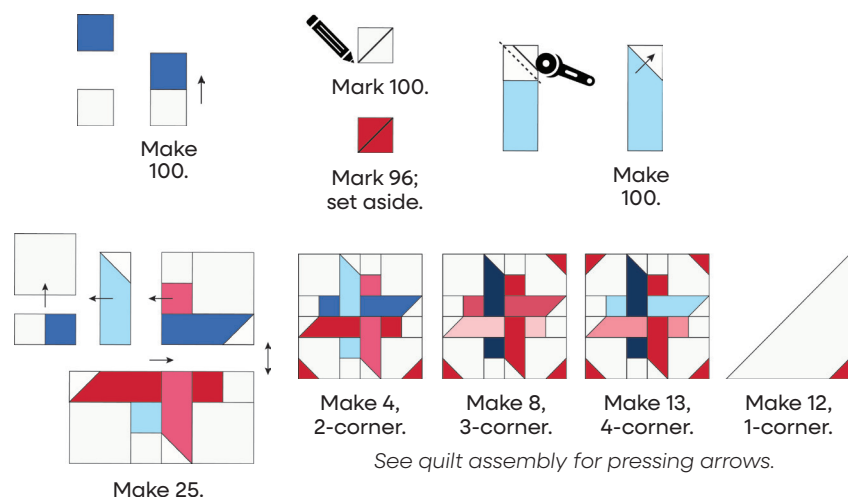
stitch to the left edge of the pieced rectangle to make a unit. Make 4. Sew units into rows. Sew the rows together to make the Celtic Knots block measuring 12½" x 12½". Make 25.

4. Using the (96) marked block corner squares, place (2) squares onto the bottom corners of (1) block. As you did in step 2, stitch together on drawn line, trim, and press to make the 2-corner block. Make 4. Continue to make (8) 3-corner blocks, (13) 4-corner blocks, and (12) 1-corner side setting triangles. See quilt assembly for pressing arrows.

ASSEMBLE AND FINISH

Arrange blocks, side setting triangles, and corner triangles and sew together into diagonal rows. Join the rows together to make the quilt top.

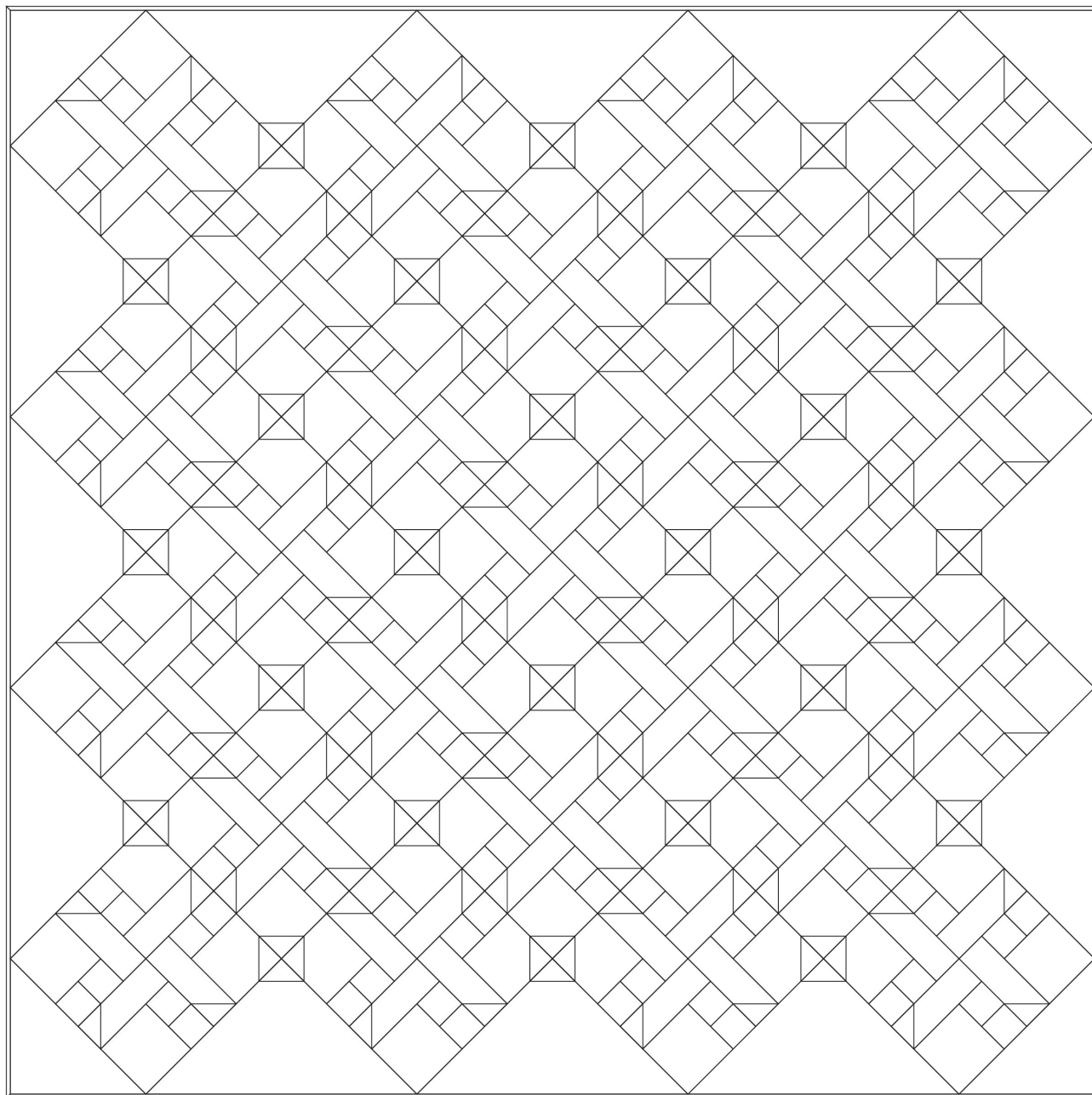
Layer, baste, quilt, and bind. Enjoy!

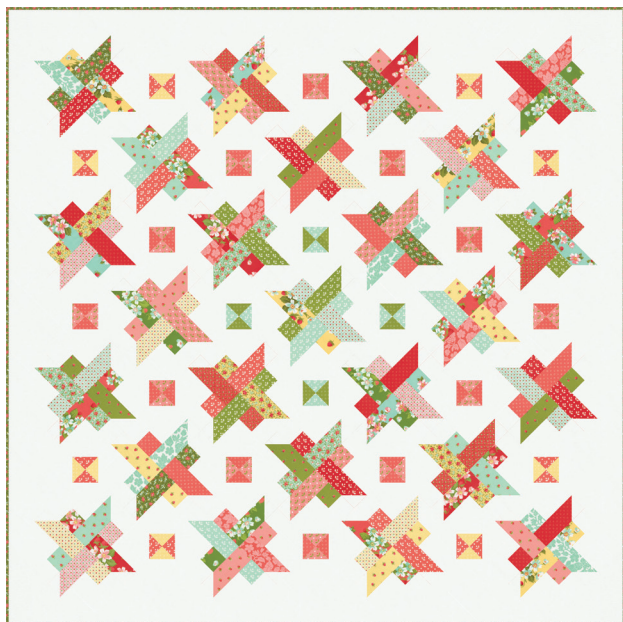

6 Fat Eighths for block corners:

Bloomsberry/Favorite Dot; 55356 12, 14, & 17

Bloomsberry/Mayfair; 55357 13, 16, & 17



3½ yards of coordinating background
(Bella Solids, Off White, 9900 200)



⅝ yard of binding fabric
(Marylebone, Green, 55353 15)
