

## **Upcycled Wrap Pants**

Use an old tablecloth, curtains, sheet, light weight blanket or throw to make a pair of wrap-around Palazzo pants! These wrap pants are super flowy and comfortable, and they will make the perfect addition to your summer wardrobe!

This project is great for beginners and seasoned sewists alike. And with the upcycled fabric, we'll have fewer hems to sew!

The pattern is available in size XXS to XXL (up to a 51" hip measurement).

These pants require 3 yards of 43" wide fabric and 1 yard of bias tape or ribbon for the ties. Bring your own tablecloth, curtains, sheet, light weight blanket or throw to upcycle!

### Skill Level:

This is a confident beginner level project. Students need to have basic sewing experience.

### Supplies:

Tablecloth, curtains, sheet, light weight blanket or throw measuring 3 yards long and 43" wide

1 yard of bias tape or ribbon for the ties

Thread

Paper scissors

Fabric scissors

Sewing machine, power cord, and foot pedal

Pins

Seam ripper

Soft measuring tape
