

Welcome to the ByAnnie bag making class. We will be making the PayDay purse. You can chose to make the small or large bag. I used the same fabric for the main fabric and the lining when making the class samples. You can choose any coordinating fabrics for the main fabric and the lining. Use fabrics you love and be creative.

In order to possibly finish your bag the day of the class, I am asking you to prepare the components prior to class. Please have all of your fabric, interfacing, and strapping cut and LABELED. The labels are found on page 16 of your pattern. If you can copy it before cutting that would be ideal. If not just make certain to label your cut pieces. Also, Section II B of the pattern explains what fabric pieces need to be fused with interfacing. The recommended interfacing is Pellon SF101 which Lisa stocks. Please fuse all pieces requiring interfacing.

You will need a 20 inch and 10 inch handbag zipper (#4.5 size) for the small bag and a 24 inch and 12 inch for the large bag. You can make these zippers by purchasing a 30 inch double slide zipper for the small bag or a 40 inch double slide zipper for the large zipper. You can also use zippers by the yard. I will demonstrate how to make the zippers on the day of the class.

This bag also requires hardware. You will need to purchase one inch hardware: two swivel hooks, two D rings and a wide mouth slider. You also need two sets of ByAnnie sew in magnets.

Bring whatever instrument you prefer to use when marking fabric. It will have to be something that can be seen on the fabrics you chose. It may require more than one method or color of marking tools. A 6 " x 12" ruler will help when making the marks on the fabric.

Wonder clips will come in handy when sewing the layers of fabrics, interfacing and the soft and stable. Please bring pins in small and large sizes. Flat flower pins will work for the larger size pins.

Bring thread that coordinates with the main fabric as well as the lining fabric.

Most of all come and have fun! I have been making ByAnnie bags for years and love how they always come together and look professionally made.
