## Each block consists of the following components. Create 4 blocks. Cut per stated sizes.



Start with 3 1/2" squares.
Trim to 2 1/2"

Each block is $11 / / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square


Blue 2 1/2 x 4 1/2" Cream 2 1/2" square


Blue 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Cream 2 1/2" square


Blue $2 \times 6$ "


Blue $61 / 2 \times 2$ 1/2"
Cream 2 1/2"


Blue is
$91 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$
Cream is $2^{\prime \prime}$ square
Blue $8 \times 2^{\prime \prime} \quad$ Cream $2 \times 2$ 2" square

Instructions for triangles


Start with a blue and cream 3
$1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Place right sides together. Draw line and sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ each side. Square to $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

Cut to size and sew on line.


Trace bee parts on paper backed fusible web. Press to fabric back and cut out shapes. Fuse on your flower.


Either stitch by machine or with floss. Use black floss to big stitch a bee flying path across the flower.
