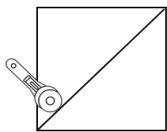
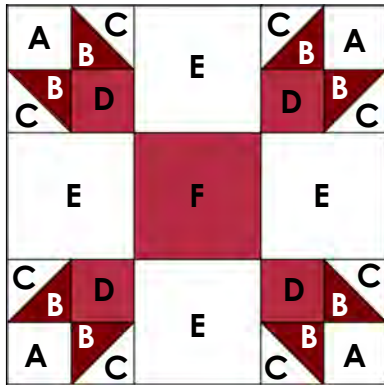

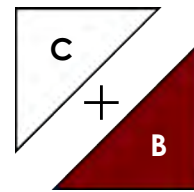


Cut Square Once Diagonally

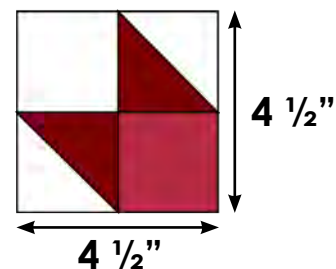
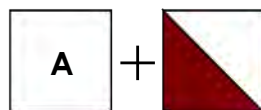
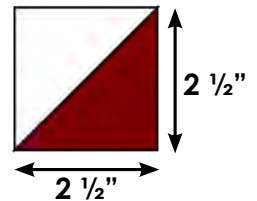
A	(4) 2 1/2" squares. <i>Grunge 30150-101</i>
B	(4) 2 7/8" squares; cut each square once diagonally to make (8) B triangles. <i>Grunge 30150-82</i>
C	(4) 2 7/8" squares; cut each square once diagonally to make (8) C triangles. <i>Grunge 30150-101</i>
D	(4) 2 1/2" squares. <i>Grunge 30150-328</i>
E	(4) 4 1/2" squares. <i>Grunge 30150-101</i>
F	(1) 4 1/2" squares. <i>Grunge 30150-328</i>

Assembly

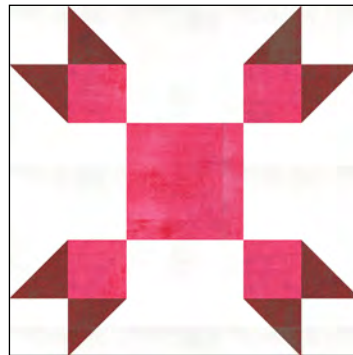
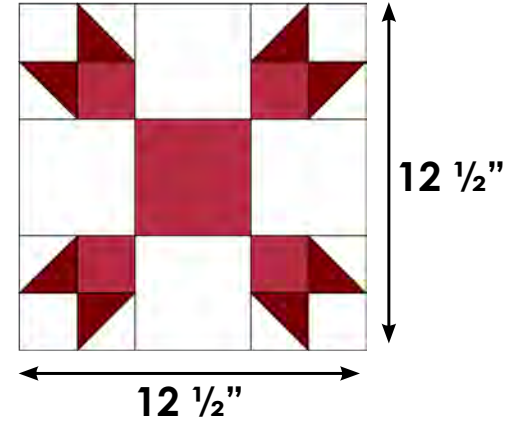
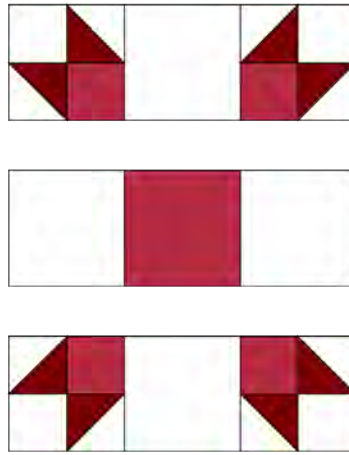
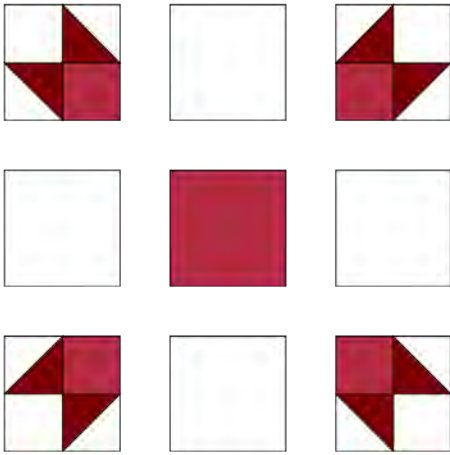
1. Begin block assembly by creating HST units. Place (1) B triangle with (1) C triangle, right sides together and edges aligned.
2. Sew along the longest edge of the triangles using a 1/4" seam.
3. Trim the HST unit to measure 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" unfinished. Press to the dark fabric.
4. Repeat to make (8) identical HST units.
5. Make block corner units using (1) A square, (2) B/C HST units and (1) D square. Lay out and sew together as shown, pressing seams toward the A and D squares.
6. Repeat to make (4) block corner units measuring 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" unfinished.

7. Lay out (4) block corner units, (4) E squares and (1) F square as shown. Sew together in (3) rows. Press toward the E squares.
8. Sew rows together. Press toward the center row to complete. Block should measure 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" unfinished.
