## Assembly

1. Begin block assembly by creating 4-patch units.

Sew (2) A squares and (2) B squares into a $2 \times 2$ grid, alternating between prints. Press toward the darkest fabric.
2. Repeat to make (8) identical 4-patch units measuring $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

3. Lay out all 4-patch units created in the above steps and (8) C squares in an alternating pattern. Please note that $A$ and $B$ squares should create chains throughout the block running opposite directions.
4. Sew the units together in (4) horizontal rows pressing toward the $C$ squares.
5. Sew the horizontal rows together to complete the block. Press to complete. Block should measure $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.
