


Backstitch


From the back of your fabric pull your needle up at A. Insert it back into fabric at B, and bring it up again at C. Push your needle down again at D, bring it up at E, and so on.



BACK STITCH DIAGRAM

Blanket Stitch


From the back of your fabric pull your needle up at A, form a reverse L shape with the thread, and hold angle of L shape in place with your thumb. Push your needle down at B, come up at C, and, crossing over the trailing thread to secure the stitch, again form a reverse L shape with the thread. Push your needle down at D and come up at E to secure the stitch.



BLANKET STITCH

Chain Stitch


From the back of your fabric pull your needle up at A, form a U shape with the thread, and hold the shape in place with your thumb. Push your needle down at B, about 1/8" from A, and come up at C to secure the stitch.



CHAIN STITCH

Lazy Daisy Stitch

From the back of your fabric pull your needle up at A and form a loop of thread. Holding the loop in place, insert your needle back into the fabric at B, about 1/16" away from A. Bring the needle tip out at C and cross it over trailing thread, keeping thread flat. Gently pull needle and trailing thread until loop lies flat against fabric. Push needle through to back of fabric at D to hold loop in place.
