- Alcoholic Beverages (you may have them, they are not included in the tour price)

THE BUS

We have contracted with National Motor Coach Systems to provide luxury coach service on our 8 day / 7 night adventure to Sisters, Oregon. Our motor coach comes equipped with the following amenities.

- Individual seat belts
- Air Conditioning
- Washroom (although we will be stopping frequently each day for shopping, stretching, eating, playing, and generally having fun.
- DVD player
- Adjustable seats
- Public Address system
- Large panoramic, tinted windows

Itinerary

This is a preliminary itinerary which will be updated weekly (subject to change)

• DAY ONE - TUESDAY, JULY 5TH •

6:15 – 6:30 a.m. – Registration check-in at Quincy's Quilting for those participants leaving from the Greater Edmonton region (coffee, donuts, muffins, and fresh whole fruit will be available).

Do not plan to arrive later than 6:30 a.m.

6:45 a.m. – Luggage to be at the motor coach.

7:00 a.m. – Motor Coach Departs Leduc for Gasoline Alley Red Deer (Approximately 130 kilometers – Travel time approximately 1 hour and 15 minutes).

8:30 a.m. – Motor Coach arrives at Tim Horton's in Gasoline Alley for Red Deer area pick-ups.

We will be stopping at the Tim Horton's in gasoline alley. This stop will last 30 minutes. We will pick up any additional passengers at this location. There is a Starbucks across the street from the Tim Horton's.

9:00 a.m. – Motor Coach departs Red Deer for Greater Calgary area (Approximately 120 kilometers – Travel time approximately 1 hour and 15 minutes).

SPECIAL NOTE ABOUT LUGGAGE:

We speak from experience on this point when we get the question "How much luggage should I bring?"

The answer is... it depends. It depends on how much of a clothes horse you are and how much you plan on buying.

We highly recommend that you have two pieces of luggage to be loaded in the storage compartment of the motor coach and a daypack or large handbag to take onto the motor coach to store underneath the seat in front of you or in the overhead bins. One piece of luggage should essentially be empty. The other should have your clothing, toiletries, and personal effects that you will need on the trip. Don't forget to pack your medications, including over the counter remedies such as Tylenol, Advil, Gravol, allergy meds, etc...

10:15 a.m. - Arrive in Airdrie for Greater Calgary area pickups.

We will stop at the Airdrie Co-Op store off of Yankee Valley Blvd. for onboarding of Greater Calgary area passengers. This stop will be a brief 15 minutes. Long enough to stretch your legs only. Snacks & beverages will be available on the motor coach.

10:30 a.m. - Depart Airdrie for Claresholm, Alberta
(Approximately 160 kilometers - Travel time is approximately 1 hour and 30 minutes).
