### Installation of KEDO SEAT 40562 "Classic Racer" for Yamaha SR400 & SR500

Thank you for purchasing our **product**, listed below are the instruction hints for installing your product, and as always wishing you the best on your rides!

### **SR500**


- 1. Remove original seat; including the original threaded bolts M8/SW12 (rear/bottom of seat); unscrew the seat, and pull it backwards.
- 2. Included in the package are 2x 'forked" brackets; shown below for the **SR500**; Mount them to the lower side of the seat.
- Mount the seat as usual with the M8/SW12 threaded bolts.
- 4. \*ATTENTION\* Remaining are two rubber buffers (grommets), two cylinder head bolts (M6x35) and a self-adhesive rubber strips; these are needed ONLY FOR SR400 Models.

#### **SR400**

- 1. Remove original seat; unscrew and pull backwards.
- 2. Included in the package are 2x 'forked" brackets; shown below for the **SR400**; Mount them to the lower side of the seat.
- 3. The front rubber grommets on the frame sit on bushings; these jacks MUST BE REMOVED and the rubber grommets are fastened WITHOU THEM AGAIN so that the seat brackets supplied mount correctly.; use the supplied cylinder head bolts M6x35)
- 4. Disassemble the battery box. Screw in the enclosed rubber buffer with threaded rod into the M6 thread (Refer to mark "A" below)
- 5. Stick the self-adhesive rubber strip in the center of the battery as shown (Refer to mark "B"). The Battery can now be safely clamped between the rubber buffer and frame; whereby the contact to the tube is made exclusively via the cellular rubber strip.
- 6. Mount the seat as usual with the M8/SW12 threaded bolts.
