

**RESOLUTION NO. 2021-9**

**CERTIFICATION OF THE CANVASS REPORT  
OF THE 2021 COALVILLE CITY MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION  
HELD NOVEMBER 2, 2021**

**WHEREAS**, Utah Code 20A-4-301(2), provides as follows:

- (a) The mayor and the municipal legislative body are the board of municipal canvassers for the municipality.
- (b) The board of the municipal canvassers shall meet to canvass the returns at the usual place of meeting of the municipal legislative body:
  - (i) for canvassing of returns from a municipal general election, no sooner than seven days after the election and no later than 14 days after the election; or
  - (ii) for canvassing of returns from a municipal primary election, no sooner than seven days after the election and no later than 14 days after the election.
- (c) Attendance of a simple majority of the municipal legislative body shall constitute a quorum for conducting the canvass.

**WHEREAS**, the 2021 Coalville City Municipal General Election was held on November 2, 2021:

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Coalville City Council acting in its capacity as the Board of Canvassers of the election, hereby resolves and declares as follows:

This is in response to an email submitted by Louise Willoughby to the Summit County Clerk's office regarding the date listed on Mark R. Marsh's **Primary** Financial Disclosure. After contacting and receiving a response from the Summit County Clerk, the Lieutenant Governor's Office, and Coalville City Attorney Sheldon Smith, I certify the Primary Financial Disclosure received from Mark R. Marsh was received and timely filed.

As explanation: I, Nachele D. Sargent, Coalville City Recorder acting as the Election Official for Coalville City, emailed all Primary Municipal Candidates on August 3, 2021, and inadvertently requested that the Primary Financial Disclosures be filed by all Candidates and to be returned by August 4, 2021, rather than August 3, 2021, which was the correct date, to continue on the ballot. All candidates were given these same instructions. Mark R. Marsh responded on August 3, 2021, and I requested clarification on his statement which he provided on August 4, 2021, with supplemental information, as did other Candidates. I certified that all Candidates were eligible to continue in the Primary election, which included Mark R. Marsh; furthermore, it is the opinion of the Coalville City Attorney that Utah law has been fully complied with in the allowance of Mark R. Marsh to remain on the ballot, consequently affording the citizens of Coalville the right to elect Mark R. Marsh as Mayor of Coalville City.
