**ORDINANCE NO. 2016-2**  
**PROHIBITION OF FIREWORKS AND FIRES DURING**  
**SUMMER MONTHS**

PROHIBITION OF FIRES AND FIREWORKS. It is unlawful for any person to initiate burning, have campfires or use any type of fireworks within the Coalville City limits commencing on the first day of July, each year and continuing through September 30th or until the ban is lifted by the Coalville City Council. Notwithstanding, legal fireworks are permitted on the holidays of July 4<sup>th</sup> and July 24<sup>th</sup>, including the day of observance if it is other than the 4<sup>th</sup> or 24<sup>th</sup>.

PERMITTED CAMPFIRES. Notwithstanding Section II above, campfires are permitted in designated fire pits where there are reasonable and adequate protections from flammable materials. Professionals that are engaged to provide fireworks in connection with the Summit County Fair, other municipal events and properly authorized and permitted special events are exempted from the prohibition.
