The newly crowned Rocky Mountain CMA Entertainer of the Year, **Chancey Williams and the Younger Brothers Band**, is gearing up for their 2018 summer tour. The band's latest album, *Rodeo Cold Beer*, debuted at No. 1 on the Billboard Mountain Heatseekers Chart, No. 5 on the Billboard West North Central Heatseekers Chart, and No. 7 on the iTunes Country Albums Chart. The band has shared the stage with dozens of artists, including Lady Antebellum, Old Dominion, Miranda Lambert, Eric Church, Brantley Gilbert, Gary Allan, and Travis Tritt. Williams says nothing beats the opportunity to have occasionally been direct support for their hero legends like Chris LeDoux, Alabama, Merle Haggard, and Dwight Yoakam. In December, the band performed at the Opening Ceremony of the 9th round of the Wrangler National Finals Rodeo in Las Vegas. Williams also performed at the opening ceremony of the WNFR in 2016. Always proud to represent his home State of Wyoming, Williams was recently chosen as one of five artists from around the country, including Darius Rucker, to be featured in the BBC's *USA Through Music*. "We just love to play, travel, record our music and represent the great state of Wyoming," said Williams, "It's just in our blood, I can't imagine doing anything else."
