Spool of Flowers - Collage Quilting Techniques

This technique is fun and easy, and your results will be amazing.

Pattern designer Laura Heine has many Collage Patterns and Eve has chosen the Spool of Flowers pattern to provide the possibility of finishing your project in a day.

Date: May 24th and class time is 10 a.m. – 3 p.m. The class fee is \$35.00.

Supplies Needed:

Thread and Needle:

- 1 -fat quarter of a small stripe for the thread on the spool
- 3"x5" square of a gold fabric for the top of your needle
- 3" x 22" of a silvery fabric for your needle

Wooden spool:

- 24" x 5 1/2" of a brown
- 8" x 11" cream to tan fabric
- 5" x 11" tan to brown fabric
- 6" square of dark brown or black fabric

Cuttables:

• 5" x 11" or larger scraps that are large flowers, butterflies, birds, leaves, a cloth tape measure, or fabric with a tape measure printed on it.

Backgrounds:

• black and/or dark grey fabrics with a slight print - 6-8 different fat quarters or large scraps at least 11" square.

General Supplies:

- ¾ yard of Pattern Ease
- 3 1/2 yards of 24" wide Steam-A-Seam
- 1 yard of fabric for backing
- Basic sewing supplies
- #2 pencil
- small scissors
- applique pressing sheet
