FABRIC CUTTING

FROM THE JELLY ROLL PRINTS: Each tree is made up of a left block and a right block. Two blocks make one tree. Twelve tree blocks make up the quilt.

Note: To duplicate the cover quilt illustration, divide the prints into 4 groups; a red group, a green group, a black group and an ivory group. Choose 6 or 7 prints within a color group for each block. Duplicate prints within a block are ok.

For EACH of the 24 blocks you will need:	
QUANTITY	SIZE
1	2½" x 8½"
1	2½" x 7½"
1	2½" x 6½"
1	2½" x 5½"
1	2½" x 4½"
1	2½" x 3½"
1	2½" x 2½"

FROM THE BACKGROUND SOLID:

For ALL 24 BLOCKS you will need:

25	2½" X WOF	24	2½" X 8½"

		24	2½" X 4½"
		24	2½" X 3½"
		168	2½" X 2½"

For the BORDERS you will need:			
QTY	SIZE	INSTRUCTIONS	
6	4½" X WOF	Strips will be pieced for the borders. Wait until quilt top is assembled to make sure measurements are accurate.	

Quilt is 56" x 64".

Read all instructions before beginning this project.

All instructions include a ¼" seam allowance

WOF = Width of fabric.

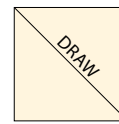
FABRIC CUTTING

FROM SKU 10053-14:

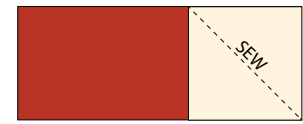
For the QUILT BINDING you will need:		
QTY	SIZE	INSTRUCTIONS
7	2¼" X WOF OR Remaining Jelly Roll Strips	Sew together as desired into one long strip.

Making Sew N' Flip Triangles

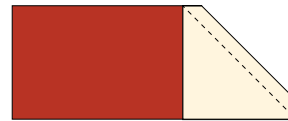


2½"



LAYER

Draw a diagonal line on the back of a 2½" square. Layer the square, right sides together, onto a rectangle. Sew on the drawn line.



TRIM



PRESS

Trim ¼" from the sewn line. Press the corner open to reveal the triangle.



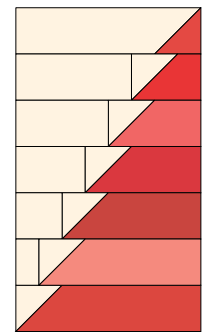
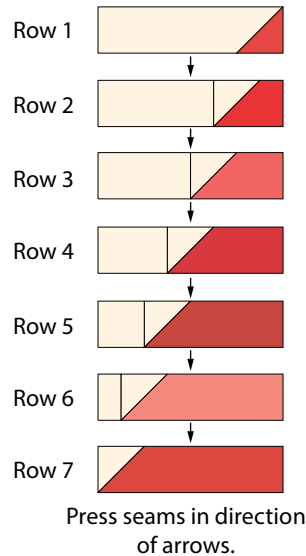
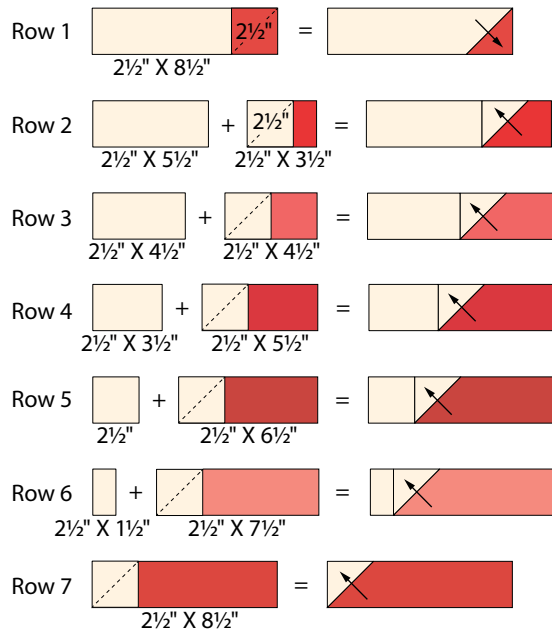
Use ¼" seams and press in the direction of the arrows.

CUTTING AND CONSTRUCTION

1 Make Left Tree Blocks:

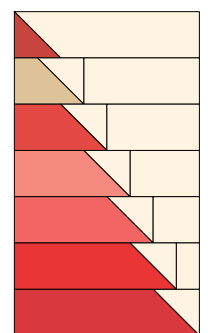
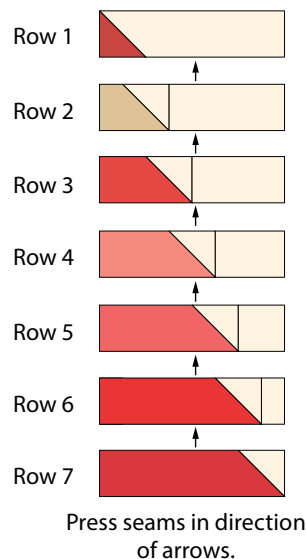
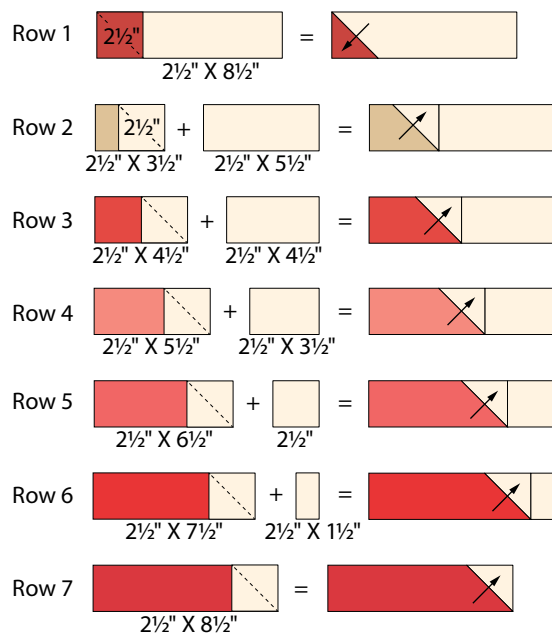
- (A) Use the triangle method illustrated in the "Making Sew N' Flip Triangles" instructions to make the 7 rows of the left side of the block. Sew the triangle blocks first, then sew them to the background rectangles.
- B) Sew the rows together to make the left half of the tree. Repeat to make a total of 12 left blocks.

2 Make Right Tree Blocks:

- (A) Use the triangle method illustrated in the "Making Sew N' Flip Triangles" instructions to make the 7 rows of the right side of the block. Sew the triangle blocks first, then sew them to the background rectangles.
- B) Sew the rows together to make the right half of the tree. Repeat to make a total of 12 right blocks.

TREE FARM QUILT Finished Size: 56" x 64"

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

TREES: 1 Print Jelly Roll*

Tole Christmas (SKU 10050JR)

BACKGROUND AND BORDERS:

(Bella Solid 9900 67)

1 Jelly Roll (25 strips) + 1 yard (for borders) **or** 3 yards

BINDING: ½ yard (SKU 10053 14)

or 7 of the remaining Jelly Roll strips

BATTING: 64" X 72"

BACKING: 4 yards

Note: the Jelly Roll will include 40 strips of various prints. This project uses 28 strips (one of each print) to make up the trees. You will have left over strips.

*Jelly Roll = (40) 2½" x 42" strips

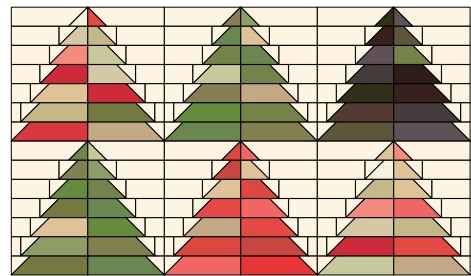
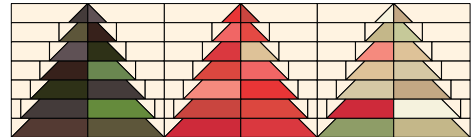
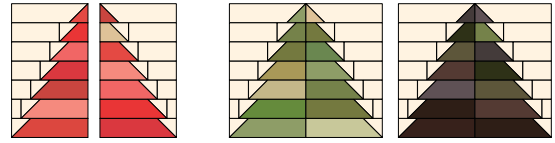

WEB PATTERN BY GINA MARTIN FOR MODA



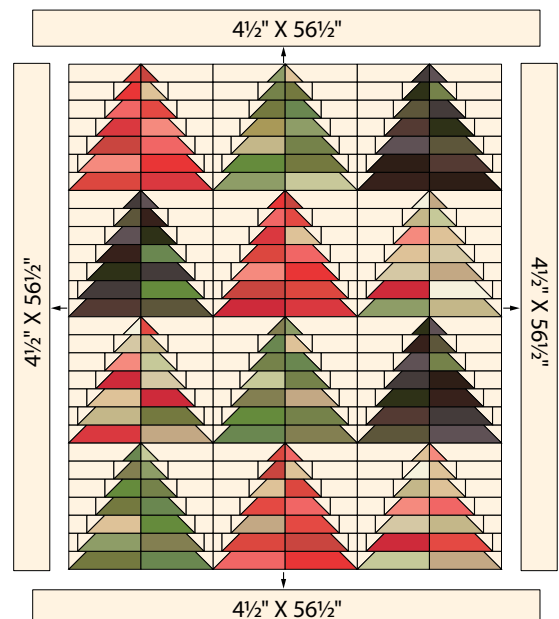
3 Assemble the blocks:

- With right sides together, sew a right block to a left block along the center of the tree.
- Repeat to make a total of 12 tree blocks.
- Sew together blocks in rows of three. Then sew together the rows. Quilt top, without borders, should measure 56½" X 48½" .



4 Add borders:

- Piece together 4½" border strips to make two side borders, each at least 56½" long. Sew borders to the left and right edges of the quilt.
- Piece together 4½" border strips to make the top and bottom borders, each at least 56½" long. Sew borders to the left and right edges of the quilt.



5 Finishing:

- Layer, quilt and bind.
