

SSI Freediving Instructor Pathways

(LAST UPDATED SEPTEMBER 2023 - PRICING/STANDARDS SUBJECT TO CHANGE AT ANY TIME)

- 1. SSI Basic Freediving Instructor \$400 training fee + FOC materials fee + \$55 Freediving Instructor Wetnotes Set + Any SSI required professional registration fees (paid directly to SSI)
 - a. Course Pre-requisites:
 - i. SSI Scuba Assistant Instructor Certification or higher (no equivalency permitted)
 - b. Minimum Course Completion Requirements (8-12 hours of classroom/pool on a custom pace schedule recommend two-four days of dedicated course time):
 - i. 4-6 hours of classroom learning
 - ii. 4-6 hours of pool learning
 - iii. Swim unassisted a distance of 375 meters or surface swim a distance 700 meters in 20 minutes or less with use of mask, snorkel, fins
 - iv. Tread water for 15 minutes unassisted
 - v. Perform a dynamic blackout rescue from a depth of 2-4 meters
 - vi. Pass the final exam with a minimum score of 90%
 - vii. Perfomr/complete at least three passing academic presentations
 - viii. Perform/complete one passing breathing session presentation
 - ix. Perform/complete one passing pool presentation
 - x. Pass the final exam with a passing score of 90% or higher
- 2. SSI Freediving Assistant Instructor \$1,000 training fee + \$192 FITC materials fee + \$120 Training Techniques materials fee + \$55 Freediving Instructor Wetnotes Set + Any SSI required professional registration fees (paid directly to SSI)
 - a. Course Prerequisites
 - i. Option 1:
 - Have completed the SSI Freediver Program (or equivalent from a recognized training agency)
 - 2. Have completed the SSI Training Techniques Specialty Program (or equivalent from a recognized training agency)
 - 3. Have logged at least 50 freediving sessions
 - ii. Option 2:
 - Be an SSI Basic Freediving Instructor (no equivalency allowed)
 - 2. Have issued at least 25 SSI Basic Freediving certifications
 - 3. Have completed the SSI Training Techniques Specialty Program (or equivalent from a recognized training agency)
 - b. Course Completion Requirements (45-50 hours of classroom/pool on a custom pace schedule)
 - i. Swim unassisted a distance of 400 meters in 15 minutes or less or surface swim a distance 800 meters in 15 minutes or less with use of mask, snorkel, fins
 - ii. Tread water for 15 minutes unassisted

- iii. Perform a dynamic blackout rescue from a depth of 2-4 meters with a surface tow of 50 meters
- iv. Dynamic with bi-fins performance for a distance of 50 meters
- v. Static performance of 2.5 minutes
- vi. Pass the final exam with a minimum score of 90%
- vii. Perform/complete at least three passing academic presentations
- viii. Perform/complete one breathing session presentation
- ix. Perform/complete at least three passing pool presentations

Note: Active status Assistant Scuba Instructors or higher do not need to complete the portions of the FITC that are equivalent to the SSI Scuba Instructor training Course content (subtract \$300 from above training fee).

- 3. SSI Freediving Instructor Certification *\$1,500 training fee + \$192 FITC materials fee + \$120 Training Techniques certification & materials fee + \$55 Freediving Instructor Wetnotes Set + Any SSI required professional registration fees (paid directly to SSI) + Travel Expenses
 - a. Course Prerequisites
 - i. Option 1:
 - Have completed SSI Advanced Freediver Program and SSI Training Techniques Specialty Program (or equivalent from a recognized training agency)
 - 2. Have logged at least 100 freediving sessions
 - ii. Option 2:
 - 1. Be an SSI Basic Freediving Instructor (no equivalency permitted)
 - 2. Have issued at least 25 SSI Basic Freediving certifications
 - 3. Have completed the SSI Advanced Freediver Program and SSI Training Techniques Specialty Program (or equivalent from a recognized training agency)
 - b. Course Completion Requirements (70-85 hours of classroom/pool/open water on a custom pace performance requirements below are in addition to the Assistant Instructor requirements above) including:
 - i. Perform a blackout rescue from a depth of 15 meters with a surface tow of 50 meters
 - ii. Perform a blackout rescue with one minute hang time from a depth of 15 meters
 - iii. Dynamic with bi-fins performance for a distance of 60 meters
 - iv. Static performance of 3 minutes
 - v. Constant Weight Dive with bi-fins to a depth of 30 meters or CWT x 5 with 1-minute rest between each dive to 20 meters
 - vi. Constant Weight Dive x 5 with 1-minute rest between each dive to 15 meters (optional if 5x20 is performed)
 - vii. Perform/complete at least one passing academic presentation from the Free Immersion course
 - viii. Perform/complete at least two passing open water presentations

*To UPGRADE from Freediving Assistant Instructor to Freediving Instructor the training fee is only \$500

*Note: Active status Assistant Scuba Instructors or higher do not need to complete the portions of the FITC that are equivalent to the SSI Scuba Instructor training Course content (subtract \$400 from above training fee).

- 4. SSI Advanced Freediving Instructor \$1,200 training fee + \$60 Advanced Freediving Instructor materials fee + Any SSI required professional registration fees (paid directly to SSI)
 - a. Course Prerequisites
 - i. Option 1:
 - 1. Have completed the SSI Performance Freediver Program (or equivalent from a recognized training agency)
 - 2. Have completed the SSI Training Techniques Specialty Program (or equivalent from a recognized training agency)
 - 3. Have logged at least 100 in-water freediving sessions
 - ii. Option 2:
 - 1. Be an SSI Freediving Instructor (no equivalency allowed)
 - 2. Have completed the SSI Performance Freediver Program (or equivalent from a recognized training agency)
 - iii. Option 3:
 - 1. Be an SSI Freediving Instructor (no equivalency allowed)
 - 2. Have issued at least 10 Freediver certifications and 5 Training Techniques certifications
 - b. Course Completion Requirements (85-100 hours of classroom/pool on a custom pace schedule) include:
 - i. Swim unassisted a distance of 400 meters in 15 minutes or less or surface swim a distance 800 meters in 15 minutes or less with use of mask, snorkel, fins
 - ii. Tread water for 15 minutes unassisted
 - iii. Dynamic with bi-fins performance for a distance of 85 meters
 - iv. Static performance of 4 minutes
 - v. Perform a blackout rescue from a depth of 20 meters with a surface tow of 50 meters
 - vi. Perform a blackout rescue with one minute hang time from a depth of 20 meters
 - vii. Constant Weight Dive with bi-fins to a depth of 40 meters or CWT x 3 with 1-minute rest between each dive to 25 meters
 - viii. Constant Weight Dive x 5 with 1-minute rest between each dive to 20 meters
 - ix. Perform/complete two passing open water presentations
 - x. Pass the final exam with a minimum score of 90%
 - xi. Perform/complete between one and four passing academic presentations
 - xii. Perform/complete one breathing session presentation
 - xiii. Perform/complete between one and three passing pool presentations
 - xiv. Perform/complete between one and two passing open water skills presentations
- 5. SSI Performance Freediving Instructor \$300 training fee + Any SSI required professional registration fees (paid directly to SSI)
 - a. Course Prerequisites
 - i. Have completed the SSI Performance Freediver Program (or equivalent from a recognized training agency)
 - ii. Be an SSI Advanced Freediving Instructor (no equivalency allowed)
 - iii. Have issued at least 30 Basic Freediver, Pool Freediver and/or Freediver certifications
 - iv. Have issued at least 20 Advanced Freediver certifications
 - b. Course Completion Requirements (24-32 hours of classroom/pool on a custom pace schedule) include:

- i. Swim unassisted a distance of 400 meters in 15 minutes or less or surface swim a distance 800 meters in 15 minutes or less with use of mask, snorkel, fins
- ii. Tread water for 15 minutes unassisted
- iii. Dynamic with bi-fins performance for a distance of 100 meters
- iv. Perform a blackout rescue from a depth of 25 meters with a surface tow of 50 meters
- v. Perform a blackout rescue with one minute hang time from a depth of 20 meters
- vi. Constant Weight Dive with bi-fins (or monofin or free immersion) to a depth of 50 meters
- vii. Perform an FRC dive to 25 meters (maximum 5 meter mouth-fill allowed)
- viii. Pass the final exam with a minimum score of 90%
- ix. Perform/complete at least one passing academic presentation
- x. Perform/complete one breathing session presentation
- xi. Perform/complete at least one passing pool presentation
- xii. Perform/complete at least one passing open water presentation
- xiii. Perform/complete one coaching/mouth-fill session presentation
- xiv. Perform/complete one stretching session presentation
