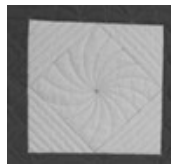
Quilting w/ Rulers on Your Sewing Machine

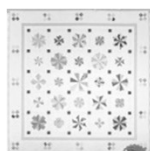

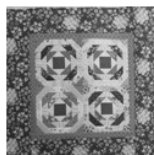
Pineapple Pizzazz

Premier+ Embroidery Software Update

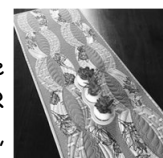

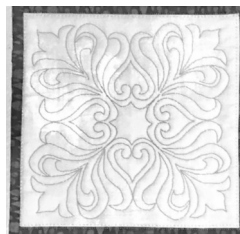
Beginning Paper Piecing

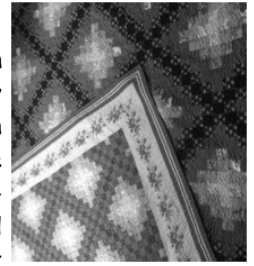
Simple In-The-Hoop Embroidered Quilt

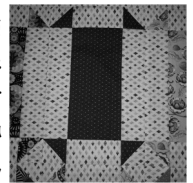
Irish Trip

This quilt is an Irish chain only simpler. Sewn in strip sets, the light to dark fabrics are arranged to make one light and one dark block, that make an amazing diagonal path across the quilt. Blocks are 14" so it goes together very quickly. Can be done scrappy, color washed, or more traditional. Patterns for both a 70" quilt and a 50" quilt will be provided. *Level: Confident Beginner & Up.*

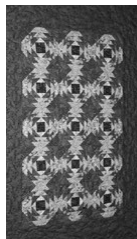
