

MINUTE RECORD Special Council Meeting City of Haven

SPECIAL MEETING

THURSDAY, JUNE 15, 2023

THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING IN <u>SPECIAL</u> SESSION HELD AT 120 S. KANSAS AVENUE WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 1:30 PM BY MAYOR ADAM WRIGHT. THE FOLLOWING PEOPLE WERE PRESENT:

Mayor Wright opened the meeting by reading the Special Meeting request signed by Borden, Powers, and Scott.

Update on Pool Project

Mayor Wright advised there's a "cosmetic" situation at the pool associated with the recently completed concrete / paint job. Contractor Larry Roth told Mayor Wright the issue would not cause any leaks or structural issues. Public Works Director Swartz expressed concern that the issue could cause pH issues with the water chemistry or sealing issues. Ultimately, Mayor Wright suggested re-hiring the same painting contractor this Fall to have the issue remedied with a skim coat. He advised that by waiting until Fall and hiring the painter directly, the City would spend \$4,000 - \$6,000 less than the \$15,000 - \$18,000 quoted by LJ Roth.

Council member Borden expressed anger about the issue. He said he felt the issue was not just cosmetic, but even if it was, in his opinion, it was 100% on the shoulders of LJ Roth. Borden said he doesn't want to spend one penny of the City's money on a remedy. Ultimately, Borden suggested the City fill the pool for the season and see what happens. Scott agreed that the issue is on LJ Roth, and the City should not spend any additional funds on the project.

Robinson felt if the fix was indeed needed and the timing didn't matter, then he would prefer to do it after the pool season has ended. Rush concurred, and Powers nodded in agreement.

Swartz noted the fifth ladder will be put back in its proper place before the project is complete and the pool is open.

Mayor Wright thanked members for attending the special meeting on short notice and ended the phone call with Borden. Then at 1:37 PM, Robinson moved, and Powers seconded for adjournment. Motion passed with four "yes" votes.
