

Please Note: The following two Ordinances relate to helping keep the City of Haven looking clean and neat.

CHAPTER XIII. STREETS AND SIDEWALKS

Article 5. Grass Clippings, Leaves, and Other Debris

13-501. Raking, sweeping, or otherwise moving grass, leaves, paper, etc., into streets, gutters, or drainage ditches.

It is unlawful to rake, sweep or otherwise move grass, grass clippings, leaves, soil, plants, sand, gravel, rocks, dirt, filth, mud, papers, stone, refuse, rubbish, debris, junk, filth, or any other material into the streets, gutters, drains, or drainage ditches along the sides of any street or alley in the city.

13-503. Penalty.

Violation of Sections 13-501 or 13-502 shall be deemed an infraction and, upon conviction, shall be punishable by a fine of \$75.00, plus court costs. Each day of noncompliance with the provisions of this article shall be deemed a separate violation.

CHAPTER XV. UTILITIES

Article 4. Solid Waste

15-404. Residential collection service; general regulations.

Carts and other containers should be placed at the collection point specified herein not sooner than 5:00 p.m. on the day prior to the scheduled collection, nor later than 7:00 a.m. on the day of scheduled collection, and shall be removed from said collection point to their normal storage location at a point behind the front building line within twenty-four (24) hours after collection.

15-409. Penalty.

Any person who shall violate any of the terms and provisions of this article shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding One Hundred dollars (\$100.00). Each day that such violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.
