What You'll Need:

- 13 3" x 3" squares for accent fabric
- Fat quarter for exterior fabric
- ½ yard for lining fabric
- Soft and Stable 18" x 15"
- 15" double-slide zipper, #5 nylon
- ½ yard of 1" wide cotton webbing
- Hardware: 1" d-ring, 1" strap slider, 1" swivel hook
- Basic sewing supplies

Pattern by Karen Montgomery

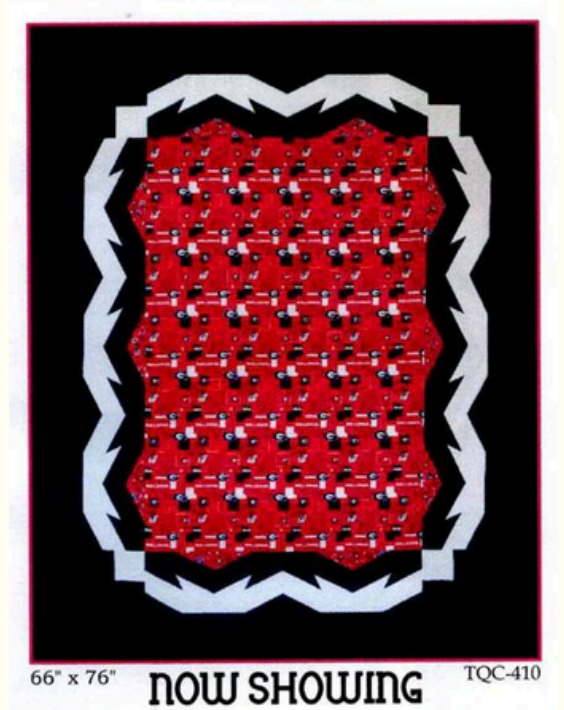

This fun quilt pattern is a Sewposium Exclusive by Karen Montgomery. The finished size is 52" x 62" or 66" x 76" with optional border. This pattern uses the Crazier Eights Template Set by Creative Grids.



What You'll Need:

- 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ yard of the main fabric for center.
- 1 yard of accent fabric (white).
- 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ yard of background fabric (dark grey).
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard of binding (for 52" x 62").
- 2 yards for optional outer border & binding (for 66" x 72").
- 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards backing for smaller quilt or 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards for larger quilt.
- Basic sewing supplies.
- **Creative Grids Crazier Eights Template Set. \$40.49**

Homework: Starch fabric before class and cut center panel according to directions.

Allover Project Bag

A great way to breathe new life into your fabric scraps! This pattern includes TWO sizes plus a BONUS divided basket option. Zip and go with a handy handle, or skip the zipper and use it as a stylish storage basket—the possibilities are endless!



What You'll Need:

- ½ yard of exterior fabric.
- ½ yard of lining fabric.
- Fat eighth for binding.
- ½ yard Soft and Stable.
- 21" zipper (double slide optional), #5 nylon.
- Optional handle: ½ yard of 1" wide cotton webbing.
- Optional: woven labels.
- Basic sewing supplies.
- **Allover Project Bag Pattern: \$14**

Homework: Exterior fabric, soft and stable, and lining fabric need to be quilted together before class.

General Class Information:

Most classes have homework that will need to be done before class. Please make sure that it is finished before class. Homework can not be done in class as the instructor will not have time to help with homework. It also takes away time from other students getting their projects finished in class. Please bring basic sewing supplies to class and your machine. Basics include: machine, thread, rotary cutter, seam ripper, scissors, and ruler. Cutting mats, irons, and ironing boards are available in the classroom. Feel free to bring snacks or a lunch, we do have a microwave and refrigerator available. Class fees are due at the time of registration, and are nonrefundable. If we need to cancel a class due to weather or sickness we will refund fees. If you are in need of assistance bringing your machine into the classroom please let us know upon arrival and we will gladly help.
