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Hand Quilting with Nancy Chong

****You will work on a practice piece at first, but if you have a quilt you want to hand quilt, feel free to bring it so everyone can see it.****

Quilting Hoop—oval—9" x 16" or 16" x 27". Must be F.A. Edmunds brand (available in store; not able to ship). Hoop sizes and shapes will also be discussed in class.

Batting: Quilter's Dream "Dream Puff" in crib size, a piece **several** inches larger on all sides than your hoop.

Thimbles:

(Thimbles will be discussed in class. You can wait to buy until then when you can try out Nancy's thimbles and decide.)

Tailor's Thimble with open end, size 11 (medium) [Leather Thimble](#), one size

Marking Tools:

(Marking tools will be discussed in class. You can wait to buy until then when you can try out Nancy's marking tools and decide.)

Thread:

(Thread will be discussed in class. You can wait to buy until then when you can try out Nancy's thread and decide.)

[Wonderfil Fruitti](#), 12 wt., variegated

[Wonderfil Spagetti](#), 12 wt., solid color

Also bring regular sewing thread for basting—any color.

Needles:

[JJ Gold Quilting](#), between, #10 (for hand quilting) [JJ](#)

[Gold n' Glide Milliners](#), #9 (for basting)

Fabric:

Two pieces of muslin or other light-colored solid 100% cotton fabric that are **several inches larger on all sides** than your hoop: : One plain piece/solid for the top fabric and one plain or light print piece for the backing fabric. They can be different colors but the top needs to be a pale solid.

If you plan to bring your own hoop, please bring fabric that will work with that size hoop. Remember that it's better for your fabric to be too big than too small.

12" or longer ruler (rotary or other see-through ruler) for marking quilting lines

Old metal spoon for basting: This will get scratched so don't bring a good one that you expect to eat with in the future! It will become a handy quilting tool.
