Supplies:

Sewing machine in working order (with power cord, foot pedal, presser foot, bobbins, and

needles)

Thread

Snips and Fabric Scissors

Seam Ripper

Pins

Wonder Clips

Frixion Pen or other fabric-marking tool

Rotary Cutting Supplies (Cutter with new blade, mat and rulers)

- Quiltworx Poinsettia Tabletopper pattern
- Size 70/10 Microtex Sharp sewing needles
- Fabric as noted on the pattern or the Quiltster program
- Thread to blend with your fabric
- Iron if you want one at your sewing station
- Rotary cutter with new blade
- Medium-sized cutting mat (12"x18" is a good size for use by your sewing machine)
- Instructor provides: A piece of template plastic
- Ruler for cutting fabric and templates (24"x6" or 6 1/2" works well)
- 12" Add-A-Quarter ruler (this speeds up the trimming process and makes it more accurate).
- Washout fabric glue stick (SewLine is a good one to use) WITH REFILLS
- Repositionable glue stick (Scotch is good not "light duty")
- Tape (for when papers rip)
- .55mm Flower Head or .5mm 17/8" Glass head pins (long shanks)
- Thread scissors (small snips for embroidery section)
- Seam ripper

Pre-class prep requires:

- Gallon size zip lock type bags
- Sharpie or pen
- Jumbo paper clips
