### **REQUIRED SUPPLIES**

Pattern: Violet Backpack by Knot + Thread

Fabric Requirements
Main Fabric: ½ yard
Lining Fabric: ½ yard

**Accent Fabric**: <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> yard (for handles, binding, pockets, and straps)

#### **Notions**

- Coordinating sewing thread
- New sewing machine needle (80/12 sharp recommended)
- Fusible Interfacing (Pellon SF101) 1/4 yard
- ByAnnie's Soft & Stable ½ yard package (18" x 58")
- Nylon Coil Handbag Zippers (1) 22" Double-slide and (1) 8"
- (2) 1" Strap Adjusters
- (2) 1" Rectangle Rings
- <u>1" Handle Webbing</u> 2 ¼ yards (Toddler), 3 yards (Adult) (Optional – Fusible batting or stabilizer cut into 1" strips to use in place of Handle Webbing)

#### **Basic Supplies**

- Your sewing machine, in good working condition. Don't forget your power cord and foot control!
- Stiletto highly recommended
- Glue stick
- Thread snips
- Fabric clips, pins
- 1/4" presser foot and zipper foot

- Rotary cutter and cutting mat
- Ruler 6 ½" x 24 ½" recommended

### **PRE-CLASS INSTRUCTIONS**

## **Cutting Instructions**

Please cut the following pieces:

- 1. Main Fabric (for quilted panel) 18" x 40"
- 2. Lining Fabric (for quilted panel) 18" x 40"
- 3. Soft & Stable (for quilted panel) 18" x 40"

## **Quilting Instructions**

- 1. Using the pieces from the cutting instructions above, layer the Lining fabric right side down, Soft & Stable, and Main fabric right side up.
- 2. Quilt as desired. Examples of quilting include crosshatching, straight lines, and free motion.

Please bring this pre-quilted piece to class with you, along with the rest of your supplies.
