<input type="checkbox"/> Sewing machine, recently cleaned and oiled, manual if needed	<input type="checkbox"/> Machine Oil
<input type="checkbox"/> Foot pedal and power cord	<input type="checkbox"/> Fabric scraps for testing tension or other issues
<input type="checkbox"/> All the machine feet you might need: 1/4", all-purpose, walking foot, free motion foot, etc.	<input type="checkbox"/> [Optional] Machine extension table
<input type="checkbox"/> Extra machine needles, specialty needles	<input type="checkbox"/> [Optional] Sew Steady table
<input type="checkbox"/> Lots of bobbins, pre-wound at home if possible	<input type="checkbox"/> [Optional] Chair cushion
<input type="checkbox"/> Screwdriver	<input type="checkbox"/> [Optional] Backup machine, especially if yours tends to be temperamental
<input type="checkbox"/> Lint Brush	<input type="checkbox"/>

PROJECTS AND TOOLS

<input type="checkbox"/> Fabric for your projects, organized into separate bags, and pre-cut at home if possible	<input type="checkbox"/> Thread/scraps catcher
<input type="checkbox"/> Small, fun projects for when you need a break	<input type="checkbox"/> Pincushion and pins
<input type="checkbox"/> Scraps or a bit of extra background fabric for each project in case of mistakes	<input type="checkbox"/> Needles and thimble for handwork
<input type="checkbox"/> Handwork project in case your machine malfunctions	<input type="checkbox"/> Fabric marking pens: chalk, Frixion, etc.
<input type="checkbox"/> Instructions/pattern for each project	<input type="checkbox"/> Measuring tape
<input type="checkbox"/> Thread for each project	<input type="checkbox"/> Tape: masking/painters/Scotch tape
<input type="checkbox"/> Notions for each project (zippers, buttons, interfacing, batting, etc.)	<input type="checkbox"/> Washable glue stick
<input type="checkbox"/> Scissors: Fabric, Thread, Paper	<input type="checkbox"/> Basting spray or safety pins, if basting a quilt
<input type="checkbox"/> Small (12"x18" or medium (18"x24") cutting mat	<input type="checkbox"/> Zip top bags for bringing home scraps and blocks
<input type="checkbox"/> Rotary cutter and extra blades	<input type="checkbox"/> [Optional] Portable ironing mat and iron
<input type="checkbox"/> Empty rotary blade box for used blades and used/broken pins and needles	<input type="checkbox"/> [Optional] Ironing spray or starch, like Flatter, packed in double zip-top bags in case of leaks
<input type="checkbox"/> Rulers – including specialty rulers needed for your projects	<input type="checkbox"/> [Optional] Design wall
<input type="checkbox"/> Seam ripper	<input type="checkbox"/> [Optional] Light and magnifier
<input type="checkbox"/> Tweezers	<input type="checkbox"/>

OTHER STUFF

<input type="checkbox"/> Paper, sketchbook, or notebook, pens, pencils, sharpies	<input type="checkbox"/> Layered clothing, including a sweater
<input type="checkbox"/> Glasses	<input type="checkbox"/> Comfortable shoes, slippers or fuzzy socks
<input type="checkbox"/> Prescriptions, painkillers	<input type="checkbox"/> Stain remover pen
