Beginning Collage

Teacher: Kim Andersen

Pick a Laura Heine collage pattern that you wish to make. Please avoid any pattern that says it's "painterly" style collage. This is a different collage method that we don't currently teach.

We also recommend avoiding the larger patterns (48" and larger) due to time constraints.

Fabric

You will need a large variety of florals and varying scales for the basic collage portion of class. You'll also need a large variety of small amounts of prints ranging from small scale to large scale. Focus mostly on medium-scale prints because they are the most useful for the patterns. You can also look for fun novelty prints you might want to include in your design.

Steam a Seam (at least 5 yds. to start with)

Pattern Ease enough for the size of the pattern you have selected

Supplies

Small sharp scissors (applique scissors are good)

Marking pen (a ballpoint pen is fine)

Applique pressing sheet

Fabric Fuse Glue

Cardboard tube to use to transport your work

Storage tote to transport fabrics and collage pieces

Tweezers
