

have 9 stitches.

Knit center stitch, SM, knit to last stitch, KFB last stitch. You should now have 9 stitches.

**Setup Row 2 (WS):** KFB first stitch, knit to marker, slip marker (SM),

last stitch. You should now have 7 stitches.

Yarn Over (YO), place marker. Knit next stitch. Place marker, YO. KFB

**Setup Row 1 (RS):** Knit in the front and back of the first stitch (KFB).

Begin with Setup Rows 1-2 as follows:

**Cast on 3 stitches using long-tail or cable cast on method.**

Stitch Markers

Size 7 DP Needle, at least 36"

One skein of Trendsetter Yarns "Merino Escape"

Materials:



Beggin Garter Stich Portion of Shawl with Rows 1-2, as follows:

Row 1 (RS): KFB first stich, knit to marker, YO, SM, knit center stich, SM, YO, knit to last stich, KFB last stich.

Row 2 (WS): KFB first stich, knit to marker, SM, knit center stich, SM, YO, knit to last stich, KFB last stich.

Continue knitting Rows 1-2 (making one ridge), slipping markers as you come to them, until you have completed 24 ridges, ending with a row 2.

The Remainder of the Shawl is as follows:

Eyellet Lacce x 1  
Garter Ridge  
Eyellet Lacce x 2  
Garter Ridge  
Eyellet Lacce x 3  
Garter Ridge  
Eyellet Lacce x 4  
Garter Ridge  
Eyellet Lacce x 5  
Garter Ridge  
Eyellet Lacce x 6  
Garter Ridge  
Picot Bind Off

Eyellet Row 1 (RS): KFB in the first stich, \*K2toga, YO\*, repeat from \* to \* until you reach marker, SM, knit center stich, \*YO, K2toga\*, repeat from \* to \* until you reach marker, and as you may need to judge a stich as you approach the count (and you will), you may need to judge a stich of the row. Don't rip out first marker, and as you approach the last stich of the row. If you get off your shawl, it will work out and nobody will notice. Just make sure there is a YO on either side of the center stich.  
Eyellet Row 2 (WS): KFB first stich, knit to marker, SM, knit center stich, SM, YO, knit to last stich, KFB last stich.  
Garter Ridge:


Row 1 (RS): KFB first stich, knit to marker, YO, SM, knit center stich, SM, YO, knit to last stich, KFB last stich.  
Row 2 (WS): KFB first stich, knit to marker, SM, knit center stich, SM, YO, knit to last stich, KFB last stich.

right needle.

Bind off 5 stitches. This creates one Picot and will leave one stitch on the

Using Cable Cast-On method, Cast 2 stitches on the end of left needle.

### Picot Bind-Off



### Repeat Rows 1 and 2

Knit to last stitch, KFB last stitch.



Transfer stitch on right needle back to the left needle.  
Continue making picots in the same manner until all stitches are consumed.
