

Bayport Shawl

Materials:

One skein of Trendsetter Yarns "Merino Escape"
Size 7 DP Needle, at least 36"
Stitch Markers

Cast on 3 stitches using long-tail or cable cast on method.
Begin with Setup Rows 1-2 as follows:

Setup Row 1 (RS): Knit in the front and back of the first stitch (KFB),
Yarn Over (YO), place marker. Knit next stitch. Place marker, YO, KFB
last stitch. You should now have 7 stitches.
Setup Row 2 (WS): KFB first stitch, knit to marker, slip marker (SM),
knit center stitch, SM, knit to last stitch, KFB last stitch. You should now
have 9 stitches.

Begin Garter Stitch Portion of Shawl with Rows 1-2, as follows:

Row 1 (RS): KFB first stitch, knit to marker, YO, SM, knit center stitch, SM, YO, knit to last stitch, KFB last stitch.

Row 2 (WS): KFB first stitch, knit to marker, SM, knit center stitch, SM, knit to last stitch, KFB last stitch.

Continue knitting Rows 1-2 (making one ridge), slipping markers as you come to them, until you have completed 24 ridges, ending with a row 2.

The Remainder of the Shawl is as follows:

Eyellet Lace x 1

Garter Ridge

Eyellet Lace x 2

Garter Ridge

Eyellet Lace x 3

Garter Ridge

Eyellet Lace x 4

Garter Ridge

Eyellet Lace x 5

Garter Ridge

Eyellet Lace x 6

Garter Ridge

Picot Bind Off

Eyellet Lace
Eyellet Row 1 (RS): KFB in the first stitch. *K2tog, YO*, repeat from * to * until you reach marker, SM, knit center stitch, SM, *YO, K2tog*, repeat from * to * until you reach the last stitch, KFB last stitch. If you get off count (and you will), you may need to fudge a stitch as you approach the first marker, and as you approach the last stitch of the row. Don't rip out your shawl, it will work out and nobody will notice. Just make sure there is a YO on either side of the center stitch.

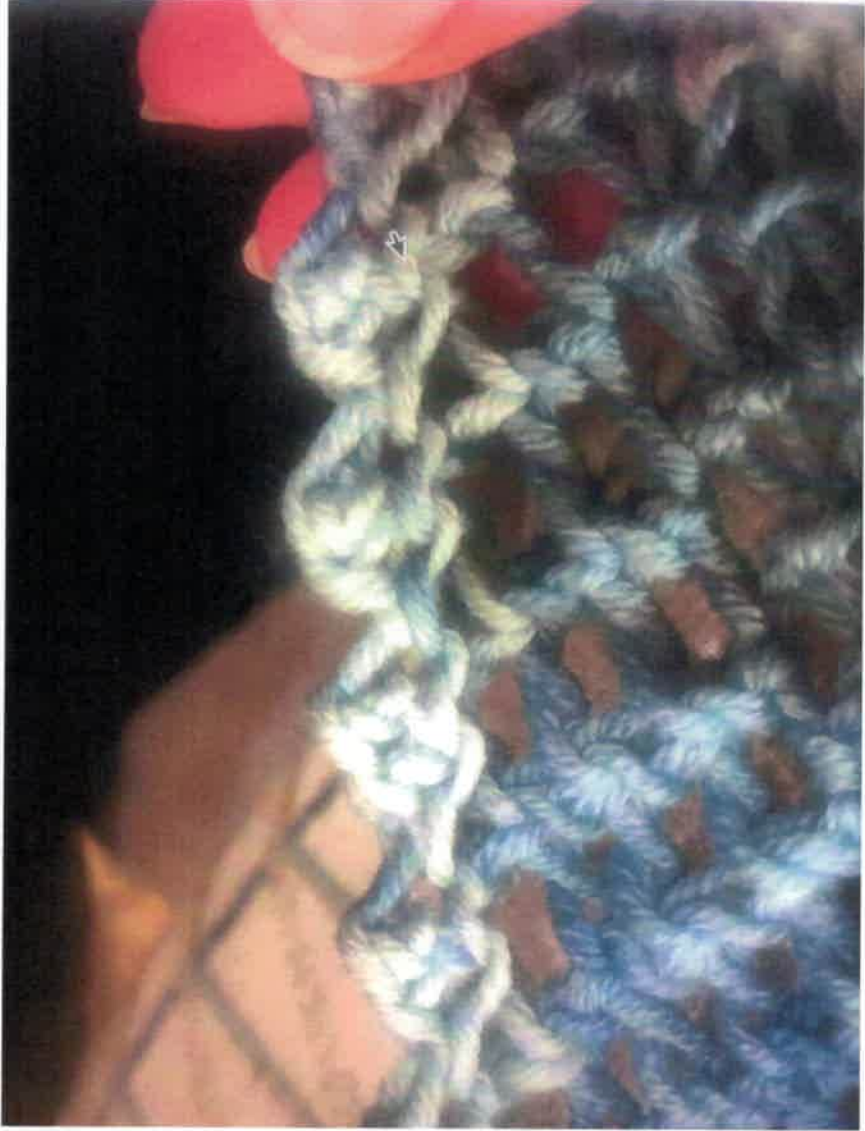
Eyellet Row 2 (WS): KFB first stitch, knit to marker, SM, knit center stitch, SM, knit to last stitch, KFB last stitch.

Garter Ridge:

Row 1 (RS): KFB first stitch, knit to marker, YO, SM, knit center stitch, SM, YO, knit to last stitch, KFB last stitch.

Row 2 (WS): KFB first stitch, knit to marker, SM, knit center stitch, SM,

knit to last stitch, KFB last stitch.
Repeat Rows 1 and 2



Picot Bind-Off

Using Cable Cast-On method, Cast 2 stitches on the end of left needle. Bind off 5 stitches. This creates one Picot and will leave one stitch on the right needle.



Transfer stitch on right needle back to the left needle.
Continue making picots in the same manner until all stitches are
consumed.
