- A. Maintenance tip of the month
 - 1. Tightening up your embroidery machine. What screws to tighten up and when you need to make them tighter. Hoop screws, needle bar clamp screw, and presser foot screw.
 - 2. Multi-purpose screw driver and all it's uses
- B. Sewing tip of the month
 - 1. Playing with the guideline marker and laser
 - 2. Guideline marker has two settings, sub-line and main line
 - Main line can be used to track needle position or used as an edge guide-can be adjusted both horizontally and vertically. Very powerful tool for larger projects. Goes out to 30mm each side of center needle position and 50mm vertically down the fabric
 - b. Subline can be used as a guideline marker-goes out to 30mm on both sides of center needle position
 - 3. Gridlines and how to use them
 - a. You can adjust your grid to 30mm. Goes to well over a 1" grid
 - 4. Sub-line and using your angles to pivot around corners
 - 5. Decorative stitches and pattern combinations
 - 6. Using your pattern shift key to create different pattern looks and combinations

 - 1. Using continuous border function-Kate's project
- D. IQ Designer tip of the month
 - 1. Creating straight line applique in IQ Designer-Christine's Read pillow done in IQ.
