

Kids Vinyl Mesh Zipper Pouch



Vinyl – 9” x 11”

Fabric 3” x 9” Front fabric panel

2” x 5” Side tab

1” x 5” zipper tie

14” zipper

- Fold your front fabric panel 3” x 9” hot dog style right sides together and stitch using the edge of your foot along the long edge. Turn right sides out centering the seam down the back.
- Fold your 2” x 5” hotdog wrong sides together, fold raw edges to fold and refold. Stitch along both long edges. Repeat with the zipper tie, but just stitch one stitch down the center.
- Position the fabric panel 2” down from the top along the 9” side. Pin or glue in place and top stitch down along both long edges.
- Place your zipper right sides down along the 9” top edge, aligning edge of vinyl with edge of zipper tape and stitch one side of the zipper in place.
- Press vinyl away from zipper tape and top stitch vinyl along the edge of the zipper teeth.
- Align the second edge of the zipper tape right sides down on the bottom 9” edge of the vinyl. Make sure side edges are even. Stitch zipper in place.
- Open up zipper, finger press vinyl away from zipper and top stitch to hold the vinyl in place.
- Align side edges of the bag, so the zipper is about 1” to the front of the bag. This will give you a front zipper instead of a top zipper. Make sure your zipper is opened up about half way.
- Position side tab in the top corner where the zipper pull is closed.
- Stitch both sides seams, reinforcing at beginning and end of seam.
- Square bottom two corners about $\frac{3}{4}$ ”
- Turn right sides out and attach zipper pull
