

Sunflower Quilt

44-1/2" x 44-1/2"

Fabric Requirements & Cutting:

From Sunflower Panel (1 yard):

- (9) White Sunflowers squares &
- (4) assorted colors of Sunflower squares
(centering flowers, trim all squares to 8-1/2")

Batting: 50" x 50"

Backing: 3 yards


From 1-3/8 YARDS Teal Fabric cut:

- (2) 10" strips; crosscut into (6) 10" squares;
cut each square TWICE diagonally
- (5) 2-1/2" strips for border
- (5) 2-1/2" strips for binding

From 2/3 YARD Yellow Fabric cut:

- (2) 10" strips; crosscut into (6) 10" squares
cut each square TWICE diagonally


1- Arrange 2 yellow triangles and 2 teal triangles together as shown. Sew the triangles together to make a square. Press, following arrows. Trim to 8-1/2". Make 12 blocks.



2- Noting the orientation of the sunflower blocks and the teal/yellow blocks, arrange the blocks as shown below. Sew the blocks into rows, then sew rows together to make the quilt center.

3- Sew two teal border strips to the sides of the quilt. Sew the remaining 3 border strips together end to end for the top and bottom borders and sew the borders to the quilt.

4- Quilt and bind the quilt, using the remaining 5 teal 2-1/2" strips.
