Bag Holder

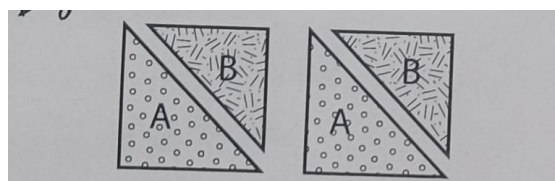
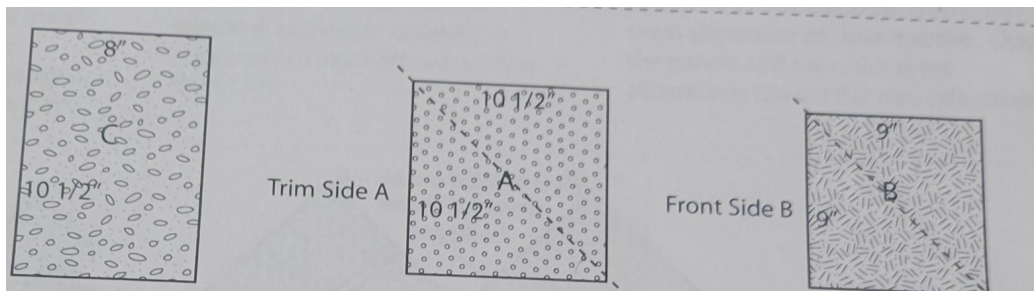
Cut: This makes one bag.

A-Binding 10- $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10- $\frac{1}{2}$ "

B-Burlap 9" x 9"

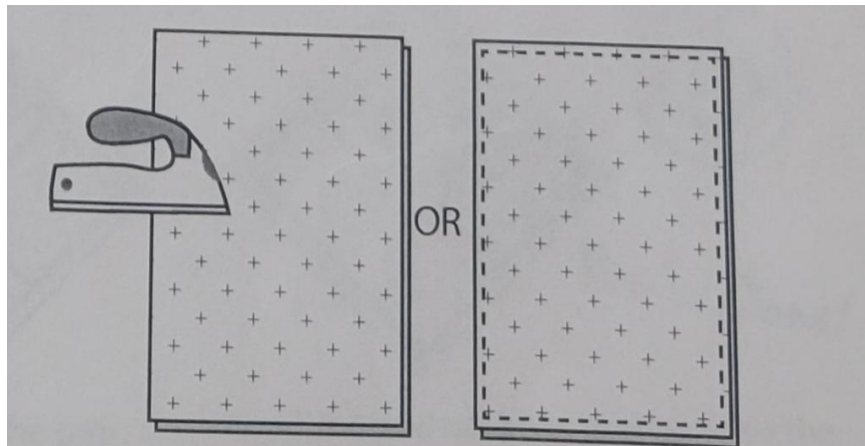
C-Print 10- $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8" Cut 2

Batting- 10- $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8" Cut 2

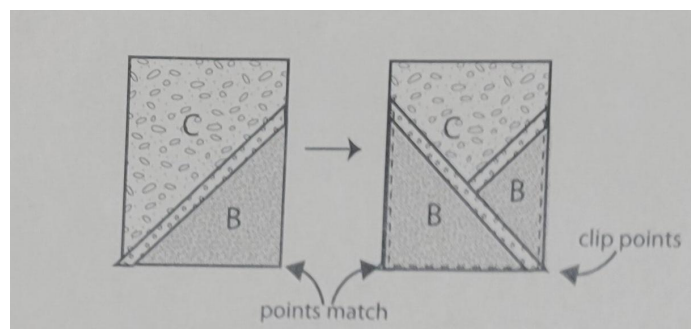


1. Cut piece A and B in half diagonally.
2. With right sides, center triangle B on top of triangle A and stitch the diagonal $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the edge.

3. Open and press the selvages toward the solid fabric.
4. Fold the piece in half, wrong sides together. This forces the trim on triangle A to reveal itself. Press. Trim off the points. Repeat for the other side of the triangle.
5. Baste or fuse batting to the wrong side of one printed fabric.



6. Using one of the triangle arrangements, align it to the bag front side. Align the other triangle on the bag front on the opposite side. Baste $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the edge.



7. With right sides of prints together, align the two bag panels and stitch leaving an opening in the bottom.
8. Turn the bag right side out. Hand stitch opening close.
