Moda – Stitch in Pink – Block 4 – Flower Power

Suggested Accuquilt cutting directions;

*Block 4 – Flower Power diagram uses 3 colors, and 8 cuts/pieces (A-H)

Piece A – light/background fabric

Need 15 half square triangle (HST) pieces

Cut eight $3\frac{3}{4}$ "H x 3"W pieces of fabric

Using Accuquilt 8" Qube, die #5, cut 16 HST pieces (set 1 aside)

Piece B - uses two colors:

- light or medium print fabric

Need 11 HST pieces of this color

Cut six $3\frac{3}{4}$ "H x 3" W pieces of fabric

Using Accuquilt 8" Qube, die #5, cut 12 HST pieces (set 1 aside)

- dark print fabric

Need 4 HST pieces of this color

Cut two $3\frac{3}{4}$ "H x 3"W pieces of fabric

Using Accuquilt 8" Qube, die #5, cut 4 HST pieces

Pieces C and F- light/background fabric

Need 4 HST pieces

Cut two $5\frac{1}{4}$ " squares of fabric

Using Accuquilt 8" Qube, die #3, cut 4 HST pieces

Piece D- dark print fabric

Cut one $5\frac{1}{4}$ " square of fabric

Using Accuquilt 8" Qube, die #3, cut 2 HST pieces

Piece E – light/background fabric

Using $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strip die #55017, cut 13" long strip

Cut into two $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces

Piece G – dark print

Cut one 1" x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " strip of fabric

Piece H – light/background fabric

Need three $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

Cut one $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square of fabric

Using Accuquilt 8" Qube, die #2, cut four $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares (set 1 aside)

Following Moda's assembly instructions, the completed 12 1/2" block:
