



Bow Tie Pillow

Materials;

- Center pillow panel: (1) 7"x14 ½ "
- Front side panels: (2) 4"x14 ½ "
- Back pillow panels: (2) 14 ½ "x9 ½ "
- Bow (1) 8"x12"
- Bow band (1) 3"x6"
- 14" pillow form

Directions;

- 1. Bow Band;** fold RST and stitch ¼" seam along long edge. Turn right side out and press with seam in the center. Stitch ends and flip so seam is on the inside.
- 2. Bow;** **Fold RST** and stitch ¼" seam along the 8" edge. Turn right sides out press with seam in the center. Mark center, then sew two rows of gathering stitches in center. (give yourself a tale @ beginning, lengthen stitch to 4.0-4.5 sew when you get the end, don't cut thread lift needle and pull yourself a tale. Separate top thread from bottom and pull to create your gathering) Tie threads and slip bow band over bow.
- 3. Center Pillow Front;** Match center of each bow side to center sides of front pillow panel, pin and baste edges to center panel.
- 4. Side Pillow Front;** Stitch ¼" seams, joining each side panel right sides together on either side of the center panel. Press seams toward side panels.
- 5. Back Pillow Panel;** Hem both back pillow panels, turning under ¼", press, turn under another ¼" and top stitch.
- 6. Join pillow front to back;** RST, sandwich all three project pieces, overlapping back two panels to match front panel. Stitch around all four edges. Clip corners and turn right side out and press.
- 7. Make a pillow form;** using muslin or any fabric cut 2 fabrics 14"x14" pieces. Sew RST around all 4 edges leaving a 3" opening on one side. Clip corners turn, stuff, close up opening and put pillow form inside your bow pillow case!
