

outside fabric- 11" X 12"

lining fabric- 11" X 12"

bunny ears outside- 12" X 6"

bunny ears inside- there is no template for this. I simply cut the piece a little smaller than the original piece 12" X 6"

bunny head- 6" X 6"

ribbon or string-30"

- 1) Follow the instructions for [applique with heatnbond lite](#)— fuse to your fabric and cut out bunny head and ears templates in your fabric chosen for the bunny parts
- 2) Transfer your fusible fabric pieces to the front cinch bag piece
- 3) Layer and position the pieces and [iron press](#) to fuse in place- [raw edge applique](#) to secure
- 4) Draw 3 lines on each side for the whiskers, then glue and stitch your rick rack down
- 5) Zig Zag stitch along the drawn lines for the whiskers
- 6) Stitch the black eyes in place
- 7) Lay right sides together the front and back of the cinch bag
- 8) Stitch along all three sides— you will want to stop and start your stitching at the top and then leave a 1 1/2" space and then continue stitching down the sides of the bag. This space will later become the casement area for the cinch ribbon

- 9) Lay right sides together the front and back of the LINING for the cinch bag
- 10) Sew all the way around three sides, leaving a 3" opening along the bottom for turning later
- 11) Turn one of these pieces right sides out and stuff inside the other piece, lining up the sides seams and pinning to secure
- 12) Sew along the top edge of the bag
- 13) Turn right sides out and stuff the lining inside the outside of the bag
- 14) Fiddle with the top edge and iron to make a crease along the seam at the top
- 15) Sew just below where the side stitching starts and sew all the way around the top
- 16) Sew just above where the side stitching starts and sew all the way around the top
- 17) Thread your ribbon tie through the bag in the casing. Tie the ribbon tie in knot to secure it
